

# PLAY IT AGAIN FRED



● Another goal.

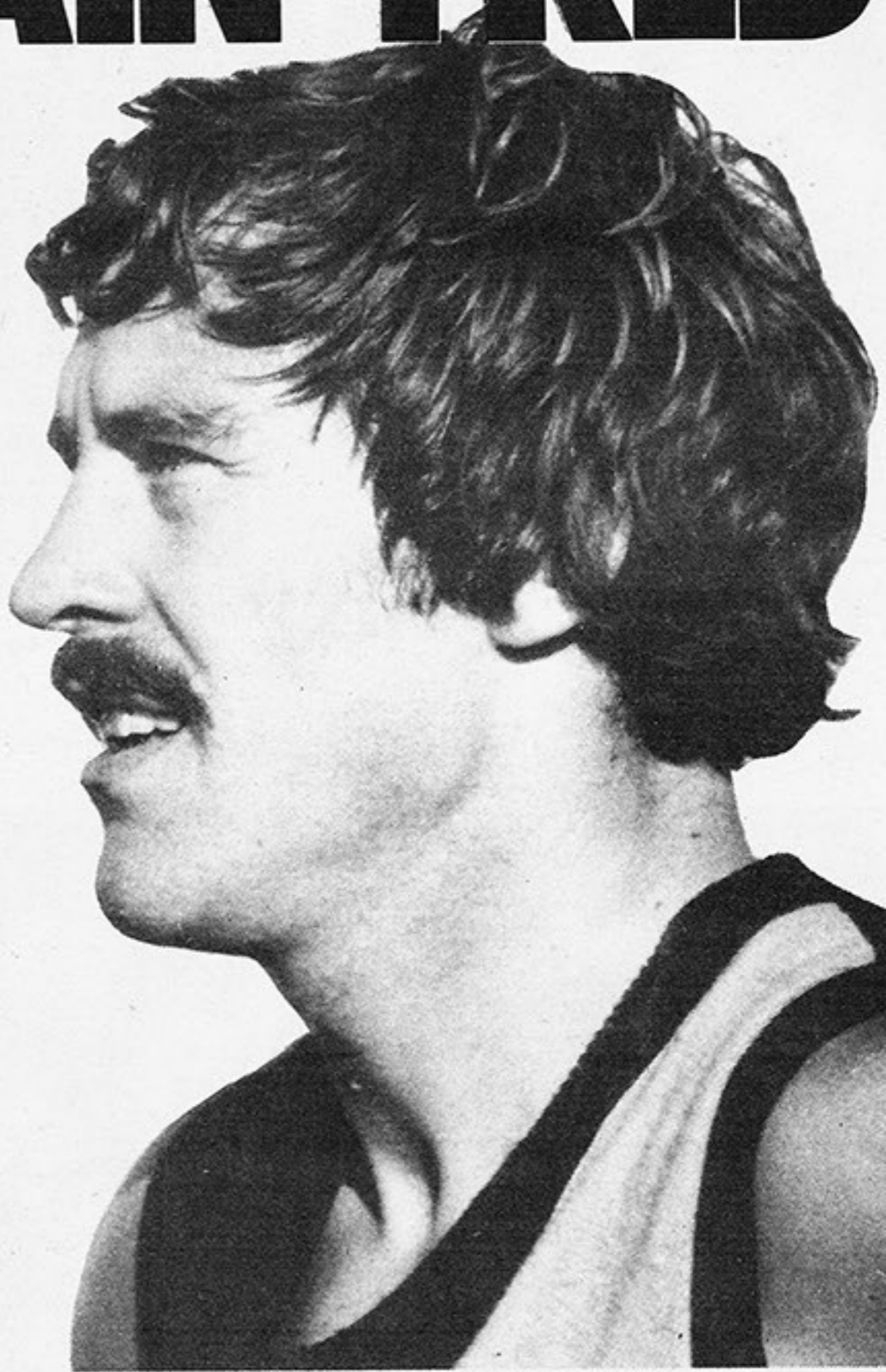
Last Saturday at Football Park, Fred Phillis reached another milestone when he broke the Glenelg club record of 826 goals held by Jack Owens since 1930.

Although he has played 253 games for Glenelg, only about 160 of those were played at full-forward.

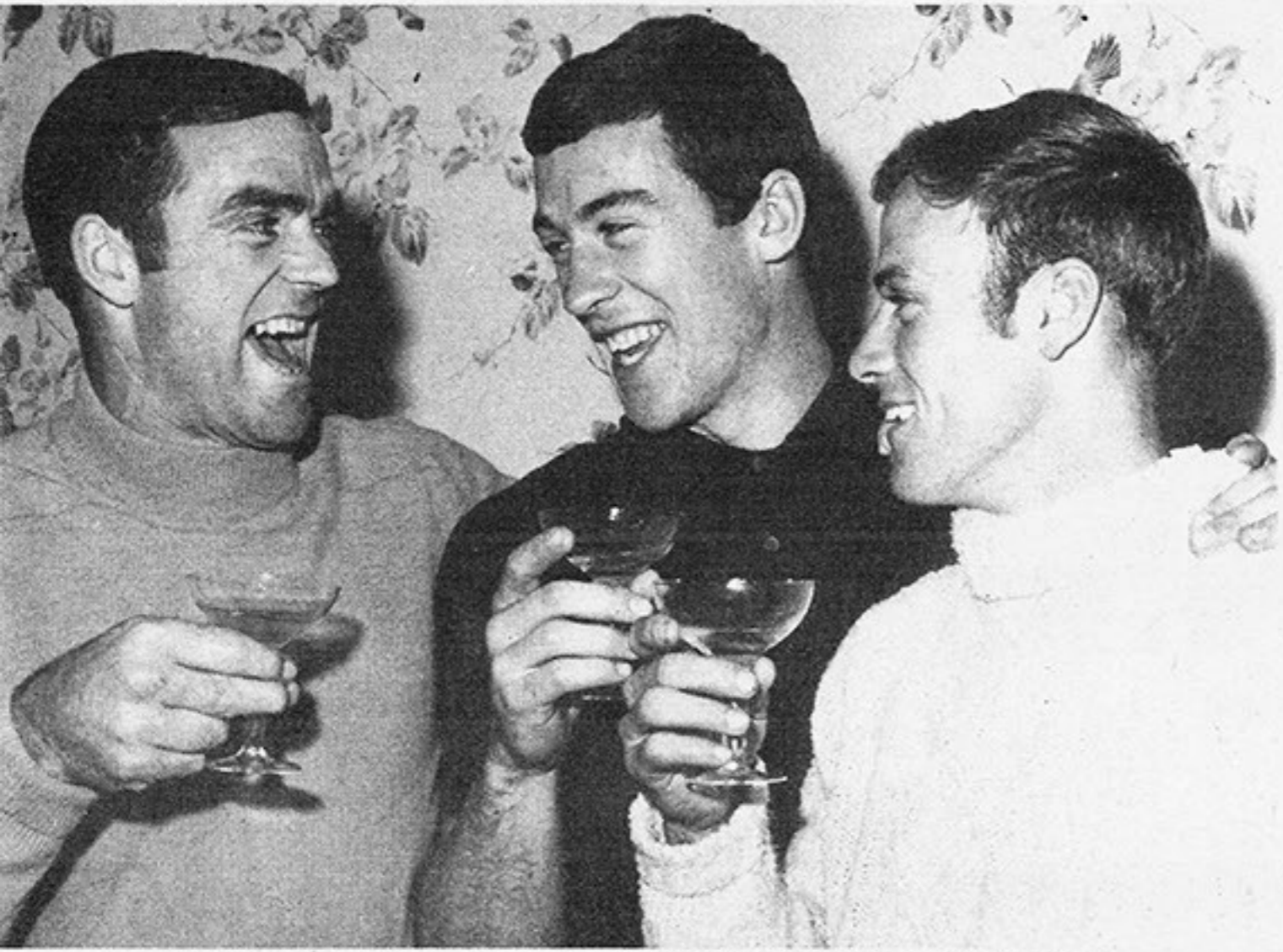
Around 760 of his 827 goals were kicked while playing at full-forward — that's close enough to five goals a match.

And is it an ambition to reach 1,000 goals and 300 games? "I just play year by year but I suppose it's tempting", he said. "It all depends on my physical fitness and mental attitude. "I almost gave it away two seasons ago but after a rest I decided to continue because I could see no reason why I shouldn't keep playing."

At the end of 1978 we will see whether Fred's attitude and fitness is great enough for him to reach that 1,000 goals.
