Cornes the star again

Glenelg 23-15; West 16-13

Glenelg and Graham Cornes, always had the answer for West and deserved their 44-point victory at Glenelg yesterday.

Glenelg were quickly off the mark and booted two goals in the first three minutes.

It looked like being a one sided affair, but West had different ideas.

By the 18-minute mark the Wolves had taken the lead as Dexter Kennedy more than matched Peter Carey, Richard Hamilton.

Grantley Fielke won across centre and Nunn and Drew gave rebound from half-back.

In addition, Michael Tate slipped away from Keith Kuhlmann for two goals to capitalise on limited opportunities.

But Glenelg under the influence of Graham Cornes steadied their defence and slowly regained the initiative.

Cornes became the dynamo for attacks particularly from the centre square and Caldwell took complete control in the key attacking position.

Yet the West defence fought doggedly to keep them at bay and the rebound of Drew coupled with the penetration of Hamilton allowed Anderson, Bennett and Fielke in for goals and the leeway was only seven points at the eight minute mark.

Bays had the answer

But the pattern already had been developed. As soon as West threatened the Tigers, Glenelg used their powerful resources to break away.

At this stage Glenelg had not received the normal penetration from Weston, but they were given a continual source of attack from Cornes and Carey.

Pressure

Midway through the third term Glenelg had kicked their way to a 49-point lead and the West defence was under enormous pressure.

West switched their side around — Les Millar to centre half-back, Robbie Donaldson and then Tom Thorn to centre half-forward.

They did give their supporters a glimmer of hope in the final term when after seven minutes the difference was only 19 points.

But again the Tigers ran through the West defence to bolt away to a resounding win.
