THE TIGERS

Glenelg survived a fiery and spiteful opening round match against Norwood to take its first premiership points for 1982.

The Tigers won the game in the last term with exciting football, despite some near all-in brawls mid-way through the quarter.

Two Norwood players were reported as a result of the melees.

Ruckman Neil Button was reported for allegedly striking Tiger ruckman Peter Carey with a forearm during the last quarter and Jim Thiel was reported for allegedly striking Glenelg centre half-forward Stephen Kernahan with a clenched fist also in the last quarter.

Umpire Bob Scholefield made both reports.

Snappy

Ironically it was the last term trouble which won the game for the Tigers.

They lifted after tempers cooled and went on to record a 19-point victory.

But at the end of the third it looked as though the Redlegs might race to a good win as revenge to last season's preliminary final.

Norwood led by 10 points at the last change and a disputed free to Jim Michalannev early in the last quarter gave the Redlegs their twelfth goal.

But only a minute later Glenelg's snappy Ralph Sewer put his second on the board, followed by a major by John Paynter and the Tigers were back

in the match.

One of the brawls erupted and when play resumed, Glenelg slammed on another goal to regain the lead, which it had lost in the third quarter.

That was the turning point for the Bays.

David Marshall goaled from near the centre square when the ball seemed to come off the hands of a pack and the Tigers were streaming ahead.

Norwood made a belated push for the points in the last quarter with the Tigers leading by 25 points.

Quick goals from Michael Aish and Greg Turbill gave the Redlegs some hope but it was too late.

Graham Cornes grabbed the ball at centre half-forward and, screwing it over his left shoulder on the run, put the seal on the game.

The Bays had taken the game by 19 points.

Norwood's opportunity came in the third quarter when Greg Nicholson went down in a pack. He lay on the ground without stirring.

He was carried from the ground on a stretcher while the game was halted.

Duels

Club officials later reported he had been taken to hospital with concussion for observation overnight.

Each Norwood player seemed to take the injury personally and played with one object in the third quarter—to win.

Button started to take over the ruck duels with Carey in the centre but the Tigers continued to tackle fiercely, as they did all day.

Norwood's vice-captain Greg Turbill and Frank Stemper turned it on in the third term and were a driving force in the Redleg revival.

Quiet

It was Carey's 250th league game and Norwood recruit and former West Torrens captain Neville Roberts' first league game with the Redlegs.

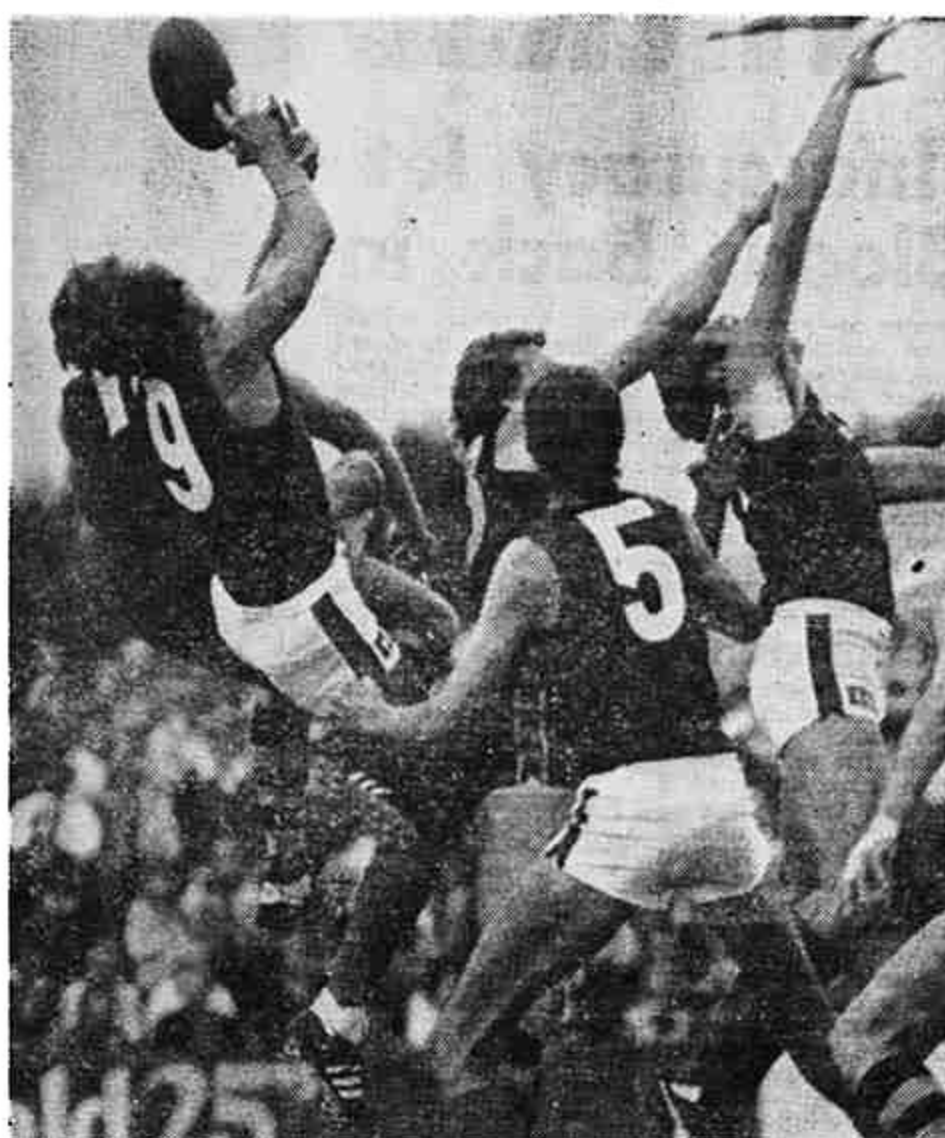
Both were relatively quiet although Carey did have some say in ruck duels.
