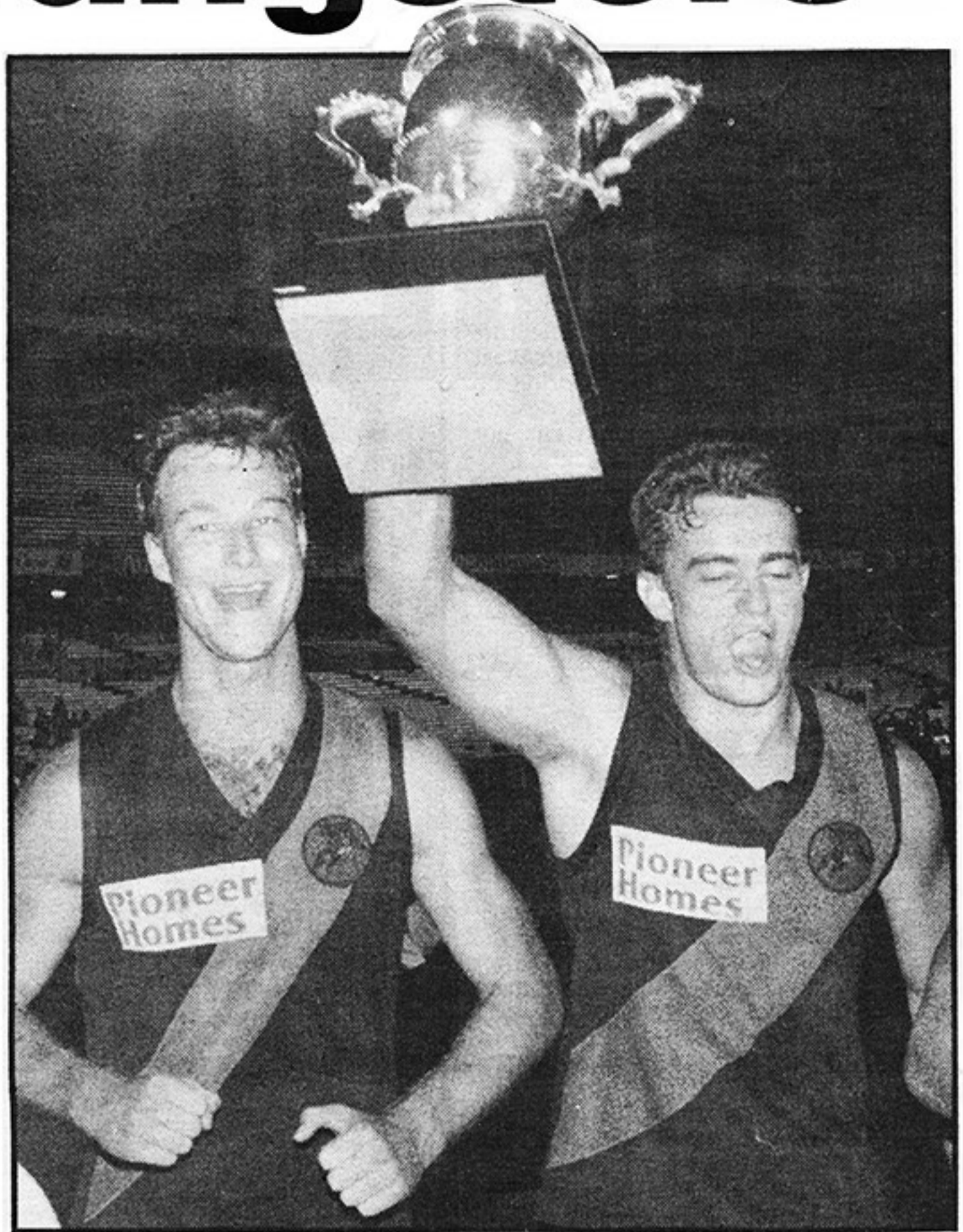


Bay youngsters lead waltz

More than most, Glenelg mastermind Kym Hodgeman fully realises the harsh realities of football — the roller-coaster highs and lows, the triumphs and the frustrations.

But the former champion Tiger rover, in his second season as coach at the Bay, could be forgiven for looking towards season 1992 with a good slice of optimism.

Minutes after the final siren at Football Park on Friday night, a big smile creased Hodgeman's face.

The Tigers had just waltzed away with a cool \$17,500 first prize with victory over Sturt in the grand final of the Foundation Cup ... and the Glenelg maestro was delighted.

"It was very, very pleasing," Hodgeman said yesterday.

"We've been building up for the first minor-round game and it was just pleasing to see the way the side performed.

"It's the first time, I suppose, since 1985-86, that Glenelg has started to show some arrogance and intimidation.

"If we can keep the players fit and in form, we're going to have a reasonably good season."

The Tigers had numerous good players on Friday night, including a host of outstandingly talented youngsters such as Mark Viska, Simon Hele and Paul Rouvray.

"It was a year we had to have last year," Hodgeman said.

"We played 41 players

at league level last year.

"We gave them experience at that level and I think it's going to show through in the next couple of years at Glenelg."

Sturt, which won \$10,000 as runner-up, disappointed, but it is heading in the right direction.

The Blues' pre-season form has been good enough to suggest they are definite improvers. They would have learned much from the clash — all part of the learning curve.

Glenelg's Viska, a member of the Crows squad, was courage personified. Not one to be intimidated, he's a youngster with a tremendous amount of ability.

Glenelg officials remain confident powerful full forward John Fidge will be available for the club's opening-round clash against South Adelaide at Glenelg on Saturday.

Fidge, frustrated by injury in recent times, injured an elbow late on Friday night. He had the arm immediately packed in ice and strapped.

In the earlier Foundation Cup consolation final, South proved too strong for Port Adelaide to win by 38-points — 15.16 (106) to 10.8 (68).
