**CHARGING EAGLES**

The Eagles, battling for the vital double chance, added yet another scalp to their belts with a convincing victory over Glenelg at Football Park yesterday.

It was the club's seventh successive win and once again highlighted it is a very real contender for the 1992 premiership crown.

Woodville-West Torrens won by 36 points to bring the Tigers back to earth with an almighty thud.

The Eagles, charging towards the finals, had many good players yesterday including Simon Neave (3 goals), strong-marking forward Andrew Taylor (6 goals) and talented ruckman Stuart Nicol.

The defence was again dependable in the crunch. Paul Bulluss rebounded strongly at centre half-back, Jamie Tape continued to impress around the packs, and captain Peter Schwarz, Scott Morphett and Stephen Sziller worked hard.

Full back Allan Schwartz was given the monumental task of minding the dangerous John Fidge and kept the Glenelg spearhead down to four goals.

Glenelg opened impressively enough. It played with authority early to open up a 24 point lead at quarter time.

But the tables were completely turned in the second term. Glenelg looked rattled, while the Eagles went from strength to strength. Sixteen scoring shots to one is testimony to their complete domination.

Glenelg disappointed, going down with barely a whimper in that second quarter and at the half-time siren it was a sad and sorry Tiger combination — heads bowed, hands on hips.

At least after the long break Glenelg did show more heart and desire, but Neil Balme's Eagles had done too much damage.

The Bays will bounce back — nothing is surer. But there are problems to be sorted out by the Glenelg brain's trust — and quickly!
