# **BLOODS**' **AGONY**

WEST Adelaide's finals aspirations vanished in yesterday's last round of the SANFL - allowing South Adelaide to miraculously clinch the spot the Bloods desperately coveted.

In West's titanic struggle against Central District at Richmond Oval, a defensive error allowed Bulldog ruckman Grant Coffee to goal at the 27-minute mark of the last quarter. Central won 13.9 (87) to 12.11 (83), sending West tumbling from the five. South had an agonising wait for the outcome, having lost to the Eagles by 15 points in the early game of a double-header at Football Park.


And in MELBOURNE yesterday, Collingwood bowed out of the 1992 AFL premiership race after a nailbiting eight point loss to St Kilda in the second elimination final at Waverley Park. In a dramatic finish

in which Collingwood fought back from a 29-point deficit midway through the last term, St Kilda won 13.13 (91) to 12.11 (83).

Tony Lockett led the way with five goals, including four in the second half, while ruck rover Robert Harvey starred.

At Football Park, Eagles rover Darren Klemm booted three goals in a sensational last quarter to set up the victory over the Panthers, 13.12 (90) to 11.9 (75), with the Eagles finishing in second spot. Glenelg forward John Fidge booted 11 goals for the Tigers, who crushed bottom side Sturt by 63 points, 22.16 (148) to 12.13 (85).

In a shock result in the late game at Football Park, Norwood toppled minor premier Port Adelaide 14.7 (91) to 6.12 (48).



# 11-goal Fidge blitzes Blues

Glenelg, with spearhead John Fidge booting 11 goals, primed itself for next Saturday's elimination final with a 63-point belting of Sturt at Glenelg Oval yesterday.

The Tigers did it easily. Their next target is South Adelaide, a do-or-die battle. Glenelg finished sixth last year but expectations are high down at Bay.

The Tigers were never really troubled by the Blues: perhaps they should have won by far more.

For it was a clash that never promised much: day was David Marshall

after all, the Tigers were assured of finals action while, sadly, Sturt already had secured its fourth successive wooden spoon.

Still, to its credit, Sturt battled the game out with its supporters, banners and flags flying to the very end.

John Fidge was superb for the Tigers, ending with 11.6. He led and marked well, helped by some precision passing.

Once more the Tiger defence was supreme, especially through Andrew McKay, veteran John Seebohm (in his final season) and Mark Viska.

who earlier in the week announced his retirement as a Crows player.

Marshall, who has been battling an ankle injury, slowly, surely felt his way into the game and will be an enormous bonus for Glenelg next week.

And it will probably have to find a place for Rodney Jameson who has completed his Crows' duties.

Ruckman Chris Melican left the field with a corked thigh, but Tiger officials are confident he will be available on Saturday.

Sturt was best served by Scott Field (three goals), Jay Viney and centre-half back Jamie Stevenson.
