Bays burst the Eagles' bubble

Switched-on Glenelg yesterday gave Mark Williams his first win as a senior coach and burst the Eagles 1993 bubble with an accomplished performance at the Bay Oval.

Bearing no resemblance to the team outplayed by South Adelaide seven days earlier, the Tigers ran the Eagles off their legs in the first half and coasted to a 73-point win.

The Eagles, in their first loss of the year, were exposed in every department by a physically tough, lightning-fast Glenelg.

It all started in ruck for the Tigers where Stewart McCully and, to a lesser extent, Stephen Rattray handsomely beat the Eagles David Nieman and Paul Prymke.

McCully booted the Tigers' first three goals and never looked back. His 17 hitouts allowed his team's running game to prosper and it ripped the Eagles

Exciting rookie Craig McRae was the pick of them. His explosive pace and intelligent disposal added an extra dimension to the game and he capped a memorable performance

kicking 5/1. McRae was only one part of a devastating Glenelg running division which, if not winning almost every ball around the ground, bewildered the Eagles de-

fence in attack. Coach Williams had his resting runners up forward sticking to a confusing, but totally effective, game plan that produced a host of goals.

Followers Darren Mansell, Phil McGuinness and occassionally Clayton Lamb, combined with rovers Nick Chigwidden, Paul Hallahan and McRae. to cause havoc across halfforward.

The normally dominant Eagles roving pair of Steven Sziller and Nick Pesch were soundly beaten.

The Tigers often were able to bypass centre halfforward Jarrod Hocking who justified his inclusion with some important if inconspicuous touches - and spearhead John Fidge who took an early shower at three-quarter time after helping himself to four goals.

If Glenelg was on top around the packs and up forward, they were in complete control at the back where the uncompromising Mark Viska teamed with Jim West, Greg Whittlesea and Hamish Stuart to shut down the Eagles revered offence.

Whittlesea, in his first senior game for the Tigers played one of the most important roles by silencing the normally inspirational Scott Morphett, Andrew Taylor was checked by Stuart and Laurence Schache by West. Robbie Thompson and Erik Martin also capitalised on some ordinary delivery to the Eagles forward line.

The game was effectively finished as a contest by the half-way mark of the second term by which time Glenelg had sped to 39-point lead and clearly were a class above their opponents.

The Eagles could offer only token resistance for the rest of the match and it only came from Stuart Totham, Shayne Breuer, when shifted to the centre, and Sam Phillipou.

The visitors rooms were silent afterwards as the previously unconquered league leaders came to terms with a crushing defeat.

"That certainly brought us right back down to earth," coach Bruce Winter said.
