Bays hold off brave Redlegs

Premiership contender Glenelg yesterday withstood a brave challenge from spirited Norwood before winning by 31 points at Football Park.

In command early in the third term, the Tigers fought for survival in the final term when the Legs drew to within a goal.

But the victory was soured by serious injuries to two Glenelg playmakers. Exciting rover/forward Craig McRae was taken to Ashford Hospital for X-rays. He was suspected to have broken ribs and was ruled out of the State game against Western Australia on Tuesday.

Additionally, centreman Dean Bailey aggravated an ankle complaint. One of the most influential players on the ground until midway through the second quarter, the Essendon recruit was unable to return to the ground after half-time.

While the injuries were cause for deep concern for the Glenelg hierarchy, the

nature of yesterday's triumph overshadowed everything else.

Desperate to atone for its loss to Port Adelaide the previous week, Glenelg was presented with a test it could easily have failed.

But when the game was there to be won, the Bays were able to forge clear and re-establish the confidence that had come with four successive wins before the Port loss.

That it was threatened so seriously by a rejuvenated Norwood early in the last term was somewhat surprising.

The Tigers had established a clear ascendancy by half-time, when they led by 34 points.

Dominant across half-back and half-forward, Glenelg had a bevy of mid-field runners to transfer the ball into attack, where Clayton Lamb was proving typically elusive.

Stephen Rattray also was a dangerous influence,

along with full forward Mark Russell, who whose usually accurate kicking was strangely absent.

In defence, Jim West, Robbie Thompson and Mark Viska held sway against a disappointing Norwood attack.

The third quarter, however, belonged to Norwood.

Finding space and time, the Legs began to erode the leeway and by three-quarter time were within three goals.

And, suddenly, with goals to Anthony Eames, wingman Jerry D'Antiochia and clever rover Stephen Patterson, Norwood had closed to within six points.

Stung into action, Glenelg responded brilliantly with six goals in nine minutes. Tellingly, most of them were created by club captain Nick Chigwidden, veteran wingman David Marshall, Phil McGuinness and ruckman Stewart McCully.
