Impressive Glenelg yesterday scuttled South Adelaide's wavering finals aspirations with an assured 36-point victory at Football Park.

Glenelg, beaten last weekend by premiership favorite Woodville-West Torrens, overwhelmed the lack-lustre Panthers with a demonstrative and efficient performance.

Glenelg, led by ruckman Stewart McCully, forged to a 36-point half-time lead — and never looked like surrendering the advantage.

Having kicked into a stiff southerly breeze in the first quarter, the Tigers stamped their authority on the match with a dogged defensive effort.

South, unable to breach the Glenelg backline, had to wait until the sixth minute of the second term to score a goal through recovered Peter McIntyre.

Against hard-running Glenelg, which had a host of skilled contributors including Michael Barton, Simon Hele,

It had no answer to full forward Dean Caldow's presence at the goalfront and none, either, to the creativity and drive of defenders Hamish Stuart and Paul Hamilton.

The Panthers, clinging desperately to the forlorn hope of reaching the major round, lacked Glenelg's cutting edge a head of centre and predictably floundered.

The Bays, beaten by South in two previous clashes this season, engineered a fine victory built around a willingness to work and use the ball with intelligence.


None was better than McCully, who dominated Daryl Heath, Randall Bone and, for a time, McIntyre, who was starved of opportunities at full forward.

Growing in confidence, McCully shoved innumerable opportunities at Glenelg's smaller players.

South Adelaide coach Ken Sheldon's decision to counter McCully's towering influence with McIntyre paid immediate dividends in the third term.

McIntyre, a mixture of outright aggression and high skill, gave South enough of the ball for it to score 7.1. Only trouble was McCully was still effective enough to enable Glenelg to add 7.0.

South mounted a hopeful renaissance, at one stage booting four unanswered goals. In the end, however, it was unavailing.
