Eagles' hard work pays off

Eagles 12.15 (87) Glenelg 9.14 (68)

For the first time this season the battling Eagles won successive games after clawing out a dour 19-point victory over a hesitant Glenelg at Brighton Rd yesterday.

The Eagles kicked back ferociously after a handful of Bay players carried the Tigers to within 10 points early in the final term, to win strongly 12.15 (87) to Glenelg's 9.14 (68) in slippery conditions.

Two steady goals from the ever-dangerous David Niemann and a sound 30-metre running goal from Scott Morphett within 10 minutes sank the Tigers when it was within sight of moving into the five.

Rugged ruckman Doug Bailey dominated in the centre and around the ground all day and became a feeding station to the hungry Eagles smallmen. He dished out 16 attacking handballs and 14 effective ruck taps which ultimately cut apart Glenelg's over-worked defences.

Suited by the conditions the lumbering 192cm, 96kg ex-Queenslander's strength and ability to find the ball provided numerous opportunities and he was the linch-pin in the Eagles team style.

The Eagles had 195 first-half possessions to Glenelg's 146 and simply had more players willing to work harder.

Its 5.5 to 2.2 second quarter came when half-forward Matthew Kluzek, Gavin Colville, David Ugrinic, Adam Pearce and James McLure burst into the game with too much leg speed for their seemingly leg-weary opposition.

The game never reached any heights as a spectacle but that didn't bother Eagles coach Bruce Winter.

"I think there's a different style there in the way we come into our forward lines, and what we expect our forwards to do is different to Glenelg's, and I thought we did a little bit better at it than they did," he said.

"I thought our backline was outstanding. We manned up Steven Hall on (Jim) West, and I think (Hall) did a pretty good job. Maybe Mark Tylor got away from Jason Spehr a couple of times but other than that... I don't think Glenelg really got anything from half-forward."

Hamish Simpson starred at centre half-back and gave the Eagles plenty of rebound while Marty Christensen and Andrew Rogers committed themselves to cutting out their direct opponents, in contrast to Glenelg which again relied

on too few to do too much. Tigers coach Tony Symonds said "eight or nine" players were not prepared to work hard to win.

"The minute we go off the boil in that area we're exposed every time and this side has just got to realise they are just an average team of goers, and unless they're prepared to work we've got no hope," he said.

"We've got no stars, we haven't got any brilliant players, we've got a lot of honest goers. But you can't win a game if half the blokes have a go and half don't."

Veteran 147-game Allan Bartlett was a power at centre half-back, while Darren Read, Kane Johnson, Simon Hele and Nick Chigwidden battled hard.

Meanwhile, Glenelg coach Tony Symonds will face the SANFL tribunal this week charged with allegedly abusing umpires at Glenelg Oval.

The three central umpires each reported Symonds for alleged verbal abuse during the quarter-time break of the Glenelg-Eagles game.

Only captains are allowed to speak to umpires during a match.

Glenelg received 21 free kicks to the Eagles' 19 for the match, but lost by 19 points.
