Bloods on target for finals berth

Steadfast West Adelline full of options. aide stole a crucial break on its rivals for fifth spot with a dog-

ged 37-point win against Glenelg at Brighton Road yesterday.

The prized premiership points - coupled with North Adelaide's surprise loss to South Adelaide at Noarlunga - handed West (seven wins, seven losses) a small gap on Glenelg and North (both six and eight) that will be difficult to overcome in the remaining qualifying rounds.
