New-look Bays upset Bulldogs

GLENELG took its first steps towards credibility with a fine 14-point victory over a disappointing Central District at Glenelg Oval yesterday.

The young Tigers controlled the play for most of the match but only a late major to four goal forward Afan Bartlett sealed the 12.15 to 11.7 upset.

New coach Wayne Stringer was immediately into "playdown" mode amid the smiles and the backslappers in the Tigers' rooms post-match, emphasising the win was just a small step towards the goals his side had set for the season.

"We are trying to rebuild and the spirit out there was great," Stringer said. "But we have done nothing yet." With half a dozen newcomers, the Tigers started shakily, crowding the backlines in a successful bid to shut down the early Central raids.

Former Geelong speedster Leigh Tudor opened the Bays' scoring with a long bomb from 50m which had a settling effect on his team.

But the Bulldogs etched out an eightpoint, quarter-time advantage with some
spasmodic forward thrusts. A Jarrod
Cotton goal early in the second quarter
was an apparent confirmation Central
District would take control. However,
Wayne Thornborrow became an important target for the new-look Glenelg running brigade. The Bays kicked five for the
quarter and held a 16-point advantage at
the long break.

Central's lack of a key target up forward was critical in the third term as the game disintegrated into a series of packs punctuated irregularly by a passage of flowing play. The Dogs simply failed to take advantage of the breeze which favored them.

And although the Bays were guilty of disorganisation, the players are still learning the style coach Stringer expects from his team.

The final quarter gave Stringer and his colleagues on the Glenelg bench plenty to enthuse about. The hard running, agressive midfield work was complemented by the forwards.

Several times the Dogs found the teamwork which had been absent for most of the match and a Tim Cook goal at the 20-minute mark gave them a chance of an undeserved victory.

But it was not to be as Glenelg bounced back with two goals and the game. In the end, the inexperiencd Bays prevailed in what many thought would be a Bulldogs' walkover.

Stringer could not have hoped for a better start. A tight encounter against last season's grand finalist and a strong finish in which the Bays showed plenty of spirit.

His Central counterpart, Steve Wright, was a frustrated man post-match, conceding there were no positives for his team from the game.
