Eagles home despite errors

IT took a desperate last quarter and noticeable lift in application for Woodville-West Torrens to eventually shake off a nagging Glenelg by just three points in an even contest at Woodville yesterday.

The Eagles drew equal on points with South Adelaide at the foot of the ladder with an unfashionable 13.10 (88) to Glenelg's 12.13 (85) victory, but it could claim no superiority in a game that could have gone either way.

Two goals to Glenelg's committed flanker Shane Gepp within five minutes inside time-on of the last quarter narrowed what looked to be a comfortable 15-point Eagles lead when Mark Kennedy goaled after being left alone in the goalsquare 19 minutes into the term.

Kennedy's gift goal poetically sealed Glenelg's fate and underlined again how fundamental errors repeatedly cost the developing Tigers. The Eagles did not hit the lead until 21 minutes into the second stanza and traded goal-for-goal with Glenelg until taking over in the midfield in a definitive last quarter effort.

The Eagles best Ben Higgins with Andrew Payze and James McLure finally made use of ruckman Doug Bailey's robust work and for the only time in the game they won the centre square.

Glenelg had made a strong assault for the first 15 minutes for just three points then the Eagles pushed forward for goals to Brett Mancini and Matthew Kluzek, who had assisted in Mancini's goal, in two minutes outlining the value of efficiency. In short, the Eagles won

what descended into an error-ridden contest because it made fewer mistakes.

The narrow win was welcome in a bleak season, but coach Bruce Winter acknowledged the Eagles unnecessary turnovers.

"It's either a lack of concentration or a lack of ability — you've got to be honest," he said. "I thought Glenelg actually won the ball better in close ... around the packs I thought they got first hand to it and they actually crumbed better than us."

"I thought the first quarter was a reasonable standard and some of the movement from both sides was good, but I'd have to admit the standard did deteriorate and there were a lot of errors made by both sides."

"In the end we won by three points, but maybe it was because we made fewer errors rather than being a better side."

Winter rotated Payze, Mancini, Corey Lambert and Marty Christensen in the centre, but that was destabilising because nobody could quell the damage done by the tireless Grant Reubenicht. His 26 disposals were all significant and, when teamed with Nick Chigwidden and the reliable Dwaine Kretschmer, he inflicted untold damage.

Glenelg's bustling approach won more of the ball than the Eagles for three quarters and gave rookie spearhead James Bury a welcoming debut. He led and marked strongly, but kicked poorly for 2.5.
