A passionate Glenelg caused one of the boilovers of the SANFL season yesterday, coming from behind in the final term to beat reigning premier Port Adelaide by two points at Adelaide Oval.

But in a bad blow for the Adelaide Crows, Magpie wingman Simon Tregenza tore a calf muscle in the final term, which could sideline him for up to a month.

While the youthful Tigers thoroughly deserved their victory - they had 66 more possessions — Port had only itself to blame for defeat, with some dreadful kicking for goal and undisciplined acts costing it dearly.

With the game up for grabs in the final term, veteran full back Roger Delaney, filling in as captain for the injured Tim Ginever, marked strongly but unnecessarily pushed Tiger Shane Gepp to the ground after taking a mark and the kick was reversed, resulting in Gepp goaling.

Then, with four minutes left, Magpie

Phil McGuinness marked 20m from goal, but hit the post from a set shot.

"Those incidents pretty much told the story," explained angry Port coach Stephen Williams.

"They are not what you expect from a supposed top side."

While Williams was at a loss to explain Port's lack of passion and commitment, especially after being humbled by Sturt last week, Glenelg coach Wayne Stringer was delighted with his side's display, claiming it was "one of our best fourquarter efforts for the year".

"It was a real team effort and it was great to see the blokes willing to compete and work hard and I'm really

proud of them," Stringer said. "They stood up against good opposition, which is what we're trying to achieve here."

Glenelg was switched-on from the opening bounce and although it trailed by 12 points at half-time it refused to wilt under pressure.

The Tigers snatched a one-point lead at the final change and held on in a desperate last term, with Gepp kicking both of their last quarter goals.

"We were lazy. Our work rate was terrible and our overall performance pathetic," said Williams.

Glenelg didn't have a passenger with ruckman Wayne Thornborrow (23 possessions, 11 marks and 14 hit outs), follower Alistair Burke (31 disposals) and courageous captain Nick Chigwidden (33) providing the spark from the centre square.

Wingman Dwaine Kretschmer and centreman Grant Reubenicht won plenty of the ball, Shane Gepp kicked three vital goals and Josh Contin was creative at half-forward.
