Goal rush lifts Dogs

CENTRAL District consolidated its finals position and kept its top three hopes alive with a resounding 55-point win against Glenelg at the Bay oval yesterday.

The Bulldogs set their victory up in the opening term when they restricted Glenelg to three goals despite kicking against a four-goal wind.

The Tigers battled hard to stay in the game and trail by just 10 points at half-time but were overwhelmed in the second half when Central banged on nine goals to two in a performance coach Peter Jonas described as one of its best for the season.

"It was an important game for us and the boys came up trumps," he said.

"The great thing about this game was our use of the ball out of the centre.

"Our mid-fielders got hold of it and delivered it well, which made all the difference to our ability to finish off our work.

"It was a step in the right direction with the finals approaching."

Central, which has struggled for goals all season, had 32 scoring shots and made the most of its 48 forays into the 50m zone.

Mid-fielders James Saywell, Ricky MacGowan, who broke free of tagger Dwaine Kretschmer in the second half, and Sean Chambers delivered the ball superbly to forwards Michael Wakelin (four goals), Mark Conway and Mark



Jones and they did the rest, kicking eight goals between them.

With Glenelg going into the game without five key players from last week — Allan Bartlett, Richard Kelly, Mark Harwood, Sean Tasker and Brooke Fogden — through injury and AFL duty, the Tigers clearly were outpointed despite the best efforts of Matthew Bode, Nick Chigwidden, Rod Jameson and Alistair Burke.

Jameson started like a train but was quelled in the second half by the tight checking of his former Crows teammate Stephen Schwerdt, while the Bulldogs defence, led by full back Jason Rae, who eclipsed Power teenager Chad Cornes, Nathan Steinberner and Justin Casserly, repelled most of Glenelg's forward thrusts.

Tiger coach Tony McGuinness said his team had taken a "backward step" after winning two of its three previous matches and was beaten in every quarter.

"Central was hungrier than we were and outpointed us in all facets of the game," he said.

"We were undermanned but it still was a bitterly disappointing performance."
