T HAS North Adelaide coach Darel Hart mystified.

And on Saturday at Adelaide Oval against bottom-placed Glenelg it almost cost the Roosters a win.

North has the players and the gameplan to match most teams - for periods - but for some reason it disappears at crucial and costly times.

Saturday's nail-biting three-point win over Glenelg was a classic example of the Roosters showing glimpses of greatness and shades of shabbiness - in the one quarter.

North opened up the match in the third term with a five-goal blitz in the first 10 minutes to set up a 48-point lead.

With ruckman Lucas Herbert feeding his onballers and Brett Knowles gathering plenty of the ball, along with wingmen Scott Leal and Scott Bamford. North looked certain to kick on and hand Glenelg another thumping.

The Bays, who had lost their past three

matches by an average of 94 points, looked like they were headed for another spanking.

But North again vanished and Glenelg - on the back of efforts from consistent half-back Matthew Shir, ruckman/forward Marcus Baldwin and rookie Craig Robinson - lifted.

"I suppose that's the part of the game we are still learning," Hart said.

"We are still learning to be harder and more competitive in those situations, to be able to respond when the opposition kicks two in a row.


probably ··We dropped off some tackles and then to compound that the skill dropped off and Glenelg ran harder and worked harder.

"We are still learning how to win. Even though it was close, I always thought in that last quarter we were in control and should win."

Glenelg has made plenty of personnel changes over the past month, with coach Brenton Honor desperate to find the right mix.

Honor freely admitted his side expected to beat North on Saturday and was disappointed the Tigers let the game slip with a meek opening to the second half.

But to come back from eight goals down and get within a kick of winning the game late in the last quarter showed courage and,

more importantly, pride according to Honor.

"From where we have been and the changes we have made over the past few weeks, we'll take that," Honor said.

"We have got a lot of young players in the side and what was pleasing was the way they responded.

"They just keep having a crack and giving it their all - they don't give up because they don't know any better.

"The side we had a month ago or last year probably would have let that blow out but these kids just had a crack at it and kept persisting.

"Obviously you play to win but I can't question the way the players came back in that third quarter."
