It's only matter of time, says Honor

LENELG coach Brenton Honor says it is only a matter of time before his side is able to convert its competitiveness into victories.

In the past three weeks the Bays have come close to securing their third win of the season but fallen short at the last hurdle, with Saturday's 28-point loss to Sturt another example.

"The last three weeks we have been in a position to win and with a bit of luck we would have won all three of them," Honor said.

"I know we're not too far away from winning because we're doing the basics right and are competitive.

"It's just a matter of breaking through for a win."

The Bays looked destined to cause the upset of the season when Kelvin Maher goaled at the fifth minute mark of the third quarter to give the home side a 23-point lead. Sturt, which had struggled to use the ball efficiently for much of the first half, suddenly awoke and responded to Glenelg's challenge with vigour.

Simon Feast (20 touches, 13 marks), in stellar form all day in the ruck and attack, found a group of allies in raking left-footer Matthew Cooper (25), consistent rover Tim Weatherald (31) and wingmen Xavier Campbell (17) and Daniel Wicks (21, four tackles).

The group gave the Double Blues significant drive in the middle, overcoming the jaded Tigers to regularly thrust the ball into Sturt's forward 50m. In attack the Blues were served well by classy Brodie Atksinson (four goals), who

booted three goals in the first quarter and enjoyed the return of bustling centre halfforward Julian Burton, who was playing his first league game of the season.

Burton gave Sturt a strong presence all day but with spearhead Brant Chambers (two goals) well held by Tiger full back Paul Sherwood, Sturt struggled to fully capitalise on its third-quarter dominance. Having wiped away its third-quarter deficit, the Double Blues cruised past Glenelg with goals to debutant forward Michael Coad, Atkinson and centre half-back Toby Thurstans to be 18 points ahead.

Glenelg wingman Michael Handby brought the margin back to two goals with his third but it proved another catalyst for Sturt, with two more goals to Coad and a measured shot from best-onground Feast pushing the margin out to 29 points. The final score did not do Glenelg any justice with the Tigers stunned by Sturt's impressive finish to the game which netted 10 of the last 12 goals.

"I don't think it was a con-

fidence issue, we worked ourselves into a position where we could have won the game if these blokes had been playing all year," Honor said.

"What I saw was an improvement and the realisation that as a group we are good enough to match anyone when our best players are available. I thought we were going to win it in that third quarter. We were playing with passion and emotion but just could not sustain it."

Sturt coach Brenton Phillips admitted being relieved to escape with a win, particuarly without adding to the Double Blues' already extensive injury list.

"I'm happy to take away the two points," Phillips said.

"All last week friends and work colleagues and people I spoke to away from the club said it would be an easy win against Glenelg this week. But it wasn't. They were really tough and took the match right up to us.

"At selection on Thursday night I said all I wanted was the two points. Today was all about getting the two points and moving on from here."


