Honor vows to swing the axe

GLENELG coach Brenton Honor has promised sweeping changes after the Tigers slumped to outright bottom on the ladder with a 28-point loss to West Adelaide at Glenelg Oval yesterday.

Inspired by a dominant performance from big man Ben Marsh, West blew apart the Tigers with four goals in eight minutes to start the second term and looked the more dangerous side for most of the contest.

Glenelg's loss sees it with just one win from seven matches and with question marks hanging over its ability to perform under pressure.

When the Bloods clicked early in the second term, they had virtually a free run from the centre square to full forward Adam Richardson, who matched his season tally of four goals in the first half.

"The bottom line is it is not up to standard and not acceptable," Honor said.

"We've had seven games of footy this year and in the main we've kept with the same group of players but my patience has run out.

"We've got some lads who've been playing well in

the Reserves for the past two or three weeks and they will be played next week."

A fortnight after being without a win this season, West is now just one game out of the top five and developing a belief lacking during the opening rounds. Every time Glenelg mounted a challenge — and it closed to within 17 points during the second term and 18 points in the third — the Bloods had the answers.

West's win was underpinned by a dominant aerial performance. The Bloods took 30 more marks for the game than Glenelg.

Given the luxury of playing centre half-back and running straight at the ball, Marsh produced a clear best-on-ground performance, reeling in 12 marks and gaining 22 quality possessions.

He had been dropped by Adelaide for yesterday's match but showed he was a class above SANFL level, shining on a day when few others stood out.

"It was just a struggling game of footy and I was happy the guys persevered, stuck at it and in the end, got the result that we're happy with," coach Ian Borchard said. "We just do it tough, but I'm happy with the result coming off a five-day break."
