# McIntosh won't give up hopes of finals spot

**N**ORWOOD has a proud record of not missing the major round since 1992 and if coach Garry McIntosh's attitude is anything to go by, the impressive run won't be broken this year.

"We have never conceded that we can't make the finals at any stage," McIntosh said. "Our aim is to beat Port (on Friday) to continue our charge."

In his team's gutsy 34-point victory against Glenelg at The Parade on Saturday, McIntosh has a steady platform to build this charge on, considering the Redlegs were without a win since May 19.

Trailing for nearly the first three quarters of the match, Norwood delved into its experience and desperation to conjure what could prove a confidence-building victory. So much so, it could eventually propel the Redlegs back into the top four.

"From a confidence point of view, there's no doubt about it," McIntosh said of what the win could do for his men.

"I think if there's one thing we've done in the past few weeks it's that we've played without confidence."

"But today once we found a little bit of it (footy) you could just see the blokes grow and start to realise that they could still play good footy."

And in a promising sign for the future they have all stood up and shown they are capable of performing on a higher stage.

"I was pretty happy with a lot of the young fellas," McIntosh said. "Bratton came on and did well on the wing and they're all good signs for our club."

Glenelg again worked hard to obtain a lead of 19 points halfway through the third term only to squander it by the three-quarter time siren.

But like most of its games this year, not everything was a lost cause.

Debutants Josh Willoughby and Jamie Vlatko performed well, Vlatko's highlight being a Peter Daicos-like goal from the pocket along the ground in the third term.

It was not a bad show of skill for someone aged 19 and 190 cm tall.

"Jamie's earned his right to come in and have a chance to see where he's at," Glenelg coach David Noble said.

"That's going to serve him well. We don't want to just be giving them (league games) away."

With an unexpected finals berth now out of the question, Noble could be tempted to give more of his talented youngsters a chance between now and the end of the season.

But at eighth on the ladder, there is a win-loss record and a team structure to be wary of.

"You can't just go all-out (trying youngsters) because you've got to maintain stability," Noble said. "If you're on a program of building and developing you've got to maintain stability in your core group."

"You can't just tip the baby out with the bath water so to speak and we'll just have to manage it."
