Tigers still can't deliver KO blow

A SIGN of a successful football team is often found in its ability to kill off a team.

Despite its spiteful 24-point victory against North Adelaide on Saturday, which included a lengthy brawl on the boundary line, Glenelg is still learning this art. After establishing a matchwinning 37-point margin at half-time while keeping the Roosters from kicking a goal, the Tigers failed to go on with the job in the second half.

A trademark crumbing goal from Paul James 15 minutes into the final term reduced the margin to four goals, putting the home team within striking distance. The Tigers managed to hold on grimly but as in their previous game against Norwood, were unable to deliver the knock-out punch.

"There's no doubt that's a characteristic of where the club's been," Glenelg coach David Noble said. "The first thing we addressed was our ability to start well and now what we've got to be able to do is maintain our structures and disciplines to finish them off (opposition)." Noble and his coaching staff can only imprint a certain amount of desire to ensure this happens – the rest is in the hands of the players. "I think we've got a group who

Completing this task will not be easy on Saturday when the Tigers make the trip north to play seething Central at NAP Oval. "No you couldn't (get a tougher assignment)," Noble said. "They'd be disappointed and they're going to come out breathing fire, so we've got to be ready for them."

One way of doing this is to train on a larger oval so the Tigers – used to the confines of the small Glenelg ground – can get used to the wide expanses at Elizabeth.

"I'd like to train on a bigger ground if we could," Noble said.

"You have to address that with your drills and we have to put it in their heads to run and carry the ball a bit more . . . and to use the corridor because that's predominantly where you get good use of the ball from."


In a position to claw back into the contest, North needs to learn how to make the most of its chances after failing to do so for the second week in a row.

"We just couldn't get any clean movement or running movement," North coach Darel Hart said. "We're having some real trouble with our midfielders running and getting them to carry the ball over lines and that part of it was disappointing."

Now firmly focused on beating South – a team lacking as much confidence as the Roosters – Hart feels his team is not far from turning the corner.

"We'll keep working on what we're doing wrong and we'll set out to win the next game," Hart said. "We know we're capable of winning and we've got to put that pressure and expectation on yourself as coaching staff and as players.

"We go into our next game and you set yourself to win."


