PARTLAND

ARELY has a day passed since North Adelaide appointed Andrew Jarman as coach that the wisdom of the club's decision hasn't been questioned.

A showman on the field in his illustrious career, the debate focused on whether he was the man for the job to lift the Roosters out of the gutter. Now one victory doesn't make a successful winter. But on the evidence of yesterday's 33-point triumph over Glenelg at Prospect Oval the Roosters are headed on the right path.

Jarman made improved depth a priority over the summer and he wanted to see the players find the lust for the game which had seemingly been lost as the club staggered from one on-field disaster to another. .

"The players have been smashed around for two or three years," he said. "We have started with a clean slate.

"We have put some rules in place but let's understand that footy is about enjoyment, playing with some flair and excitement.

"There will also be some bad times, no doubt about that. The next 12 months for me is a development year and this win is just a small step where we are going as a footy club. But we are a long, long way to your Sturt and Central District, who I believe are the benchmark."

Glenelg, especially Power-listed Josh Mahoney, opened the match at a furious pace. The Tigers dominated the centre to

have the Roosters' defence under siege early. Mahoney had two goals in the first four minutes in an incredible start to the game.

The likes of Heath Culpitt and William Neely were busy at the stoppages despite Rooster ruckman Ben Hudson getting his hands to plenty of ball. Too often opportunities were wasted, however, in stark contrast to a more efficient Roosters.


Adam Heuskes is an interesting character off the field but there is no doubting his class and composure in the North backline.

The Roosters' defence was superb -Stephen Gilham, Jason Roe, Damon White and Ray Ebel were all resolute.

Trailling by just 13 points at half-time, the Tigers will rue poor discipline in the third term for enabling North to break the game apart and charge to a commanding 41-point lead. Twice the home side kicked goals after 25m penalties were awarded for late hits on North players marking the ball. The first culprit was Brett Backwell, who had his influence quelled by Luke Ivens.

Full forward Daniel Hargraves also kicked a third-quarter goal after marking the ball from a team-mate who had been given a 25m penalty. At three-quarter time it was typical Jarman when he told his players to do something to excite the coach - otherwise

he was getting in his car and going home. Roe was among those to heed the advice. being moved forward to kick two brilliant goals to blunt the Glenelg momentum it had gained early in the last term.



"There is a lot of self-belief among each other and the spirit is excellent," Jarman said. "It is good to see them have a real crack.

"I'm the bus driver. I can direct them in certain areas but at the end of the day it is about the boys taking some leadership of the footy club."
