Surprise scare but Sturt has what it takes

TURT has position and enough potential improvement to make a genuine assault on its second premiership in three seasons.

As expected the Blues beat Glerelg on Saturday – although the slim six-point margin surprised many – and it did so with the same steely toughness that underpinned its 2002 premiership. The win firmed Sturt in third spot two games clear of North Adelaide. They meet at Unley in four weeks in a match which will confirm who has the double-chance in September.

Sturt also had four premiership players watching on Saturday and three other stars – Andrew Beveridge (ribs), Andrew Whiteman (concussion) and Simon Feast (groin) – Sidelined by the end of the day.

Damian Squire has a sore neck which is not responding quickly enough to treatment but he insists he will be back soon. Daniel Wicks (ankle) and Matthew Powell (hamstring) should return in two weeks while Brett Howman was one of the best in the twos and might be right to face Norwood at Unley on Saturday. Squire's liking for opportunist goals is priceless to Sturt and something it lacked on Saturday. If Crows Brent Reilly and Marty Mattner are permitted to play finals the Blues will have even more goalsneak options to take pressure off marking forwards Brant Chambers and Stephen White.

and creativity and Sturt will have enough firepower to press for its 14th Thomas Seymour Hill trophy.

"If I get another real sharp quick bloke I reckon that will top us up through the midfield," coach Brenton Phillips said. "We're always working on (finding goalkicking options). We tried (the Power's) Brett Montgomery down there in the last quarter."

Sturt edged out Glenelg, which moved to within six points with five minutes to play, because of superior skills under real pressure.

"I wouldn't put it (the win) all down to skills," Phillips said. "We had a lot of grunt in that first quarter then we had no grunt. We tried to play pretty outside footy and they got on the inside of us."

Phillips rightly concluded that Chambers, who was reported for allegedly striking Aidan Parker in the second term, and White, who had his first possession nine minutes into the last, would have been better served with cleaner delivery.

"One of the things I do like is they've got a pretty good punch when it comes down to the crunch," Phillips said.

Tigers coach David Noble could say the same. With five changes after last week's record low score and six players with less than 10 league games, all contributing, Noble sees a future. "There was no point in turning up today and walking away ... without something positive coming out of the day," Noble said. "A win or loss was probably irrelevant, it's the way we go about it.

"We've just got to keep persevering and working away to bring those (young) guys forward until we are able to increase and improve some of our A-grade quality. You just need a group around who you can graft off for the young guys and maybe we don't have enough of that A-grade quality."
