Furious Simmons blasts Tigers

GLENELG coach Peter Simmons has launched a scathing attack on his players after another insipid loss to Sturt which put them two games adrift of the top five.

While Sturt snatched fifth spot from Port Adelaide, Glenelg had one too many concentration lapses which led to an 18-point loss.

Simmons said his Bays were ineffective on Saturday considering the amount of ball they had, overusing the handball, holding on to the ball too long, refusing to play direct and were generally "inept". He twice identified Ben Mules for "trying to manufacture something outstanding out of nothing" when "it's a simple game where you only have to do the obvious but we do the unobvious".

"No-one else has a clue what anyone else is doing," was his startling assessment of Saturday's effort, in which Glenelg was never completely out of it yet somehow rarely in the contest either. But in summing up his first season as coach after being in charge of West Adelaide's under-17s, which have

produced numerous AFL draft picks, Simmons did not hold back. "I'm surprised at how little our players know compared to how much they think they know," Simmons said before adding his team was capable of making the finals if things go their way.


"I'm surprised at how uncommitted they are to train, play, to accept criticism and instruction and disappointed that it's such a battle to get players to understand what you want

them to do."

But while accepting responsibility for all this as head of coaching staff, he said leadership was needed from within the playing group.

He said that while his team was outstanding for periods against the Eagles, South and Central District, "when it comes down to putting in, doing some hard work and knuckling down when things don't go your way, we don't want to do it".

"We're a fantastic team when things go our way but as soon as they don't it all turns horribly sour and we look for excuses and blame somebody else. Noone takes responsibility."
