Hard-hitting start

ROY Laird was looking for a response and he got it in gamebreaking fashion.

Coming off a record-breaking 158-point win against Norwood, Central District's coach was wary of a tardy start against resurgent Glenelg at the Bay yesterday. Instead, his men piled on seven goals to one in the first 25 minutes as the Bulldogs set up their 16-point victory on a diet of fierce tackling and relentless pressure which caught the Tigers off guard.

"We were aware that Glenelg thought they might have got us at a lull-type moment after such a big win," Laird said.

"We had spoken about that before the game and we were really good early."

Laying a notable 19 tackles in the first quarter, the Dogs spread the load with James (six) and Chris Gowans (four), Ian Callinan (three) and skipper Paul Thomas (five) leading by example. "That was a real highlight," Laird said of the initial tackling performance.

"That's what we were happy with last week - we played a brand of footy to win by such a big margin and we needed to carry that over into today's game. But certainly that fell away as the game went on."

That was particularly so after the first change as the Tigers finished with 18 (9.9) scoring shots to the Dogs' 11 (7.4) in the remaining three terms. Glenelg surged in the second and fourth stanzas but through inaccuracy, the six-goal headstart was always going to be too much for the hosts to overcome.

"I felt of the seven goals they got (in the first term) we contributed to five through bad discipline," Glenelg coach Mark Mickan lamented.

"And then when we went forward we still had the opportunity to kick three or four which would have made it much better. It certainly meant that our start really cost us."

Simple misses from Tom Logan and Trevor Cranston both after 25m penalties to be within 20m of goal - should have been converted in the matchdefining opening term.

A further four behinds to finish the last quarter - after the Tigers had charged to get within 14 points in the 15th minute on the back of the term's opening four goals – also proved costly.

And when Central forward Heath Lawry goaled in the 18th minute - as the Tiger defenders were caught attacking upfield after a turnover – the Bulldogs' only score for the final term was enough to tip the result in the visitors' favour.

"Going into the the last quarter we had plenty of opportunities - we did all the attacking," Mickan said. "I think we had 12 inside 50m (entries) to four for the quarter and we kicked 4.4 to 1.0 for the quarter so we had the opportunity to snatch it.

"You take out of it that you're good enough but in the end you get what you deserve and we didn't deserve to win because we didn't play well enough for long enough."
