GLENELG'S hopes of a role in the finals are well and truly alive after a convincing 64-point triumph over South Adelaide at the Bay yesterday.

The Tigers have climbed back into the top five to set themselves up for a charge at the major round with five games remaining.

Utility Justin McConnell starred in the lacklustre contest, nailing seven goals without a miss and contributing to several others.

His was an outstanding performance and he again showed his versatility when used all over the ground.

A strong mark for his size. McConnell has an impressive kick and his goals late in the third term and then in the last quarter when the Tigers were threatened proved significant.

"McConnell was fantastic seven goals off a wing," Glenelg coach Mark Mickan said.

"He showed his value to the team with his ball use and not just when kicking goals."

Mickan had demanded a more productive start after being plagued by tardy opening quarters in recent weeks.


But his request went unheeded as the Panthers scored the opening three goals with the aid of a strong breeze.

The Tigers, with Josh Mahoney, Adam Fisher and Ben Kane getting their hands to plenty of ball, launched raid after raid deep into attack only to be let down with poor delivery.

In contrast, the Panthers had limited opportunities but made the most of rebounding movement to grab the early ascendency on the scoreboard.

With the wind at their backs in the second term the Tigers took control, running in numbers and putting the Panthers defence under pressure to find a path out of the danger zone.

Glenelg spent much of the

second term charging forward, aided by what South coach Robert Pyman claimed was disappointing skills from his side coming out of defence.

"We put ourselves under extra pressure missing the first target," he lamented.

The Tigers built a 38-point buffer late in the first half. only to have the lead eroded to 14 points in the third term.

How South reacted to two successive weeks of pathetic, dispirited football - and the departure of disgruntled rover Stephen Kenna - was always going to be the question but, to their credit, the players showed plenty of fight.

David Clarke provided run. Troy Jacques was lively on the ball and Dale Ellis made sure there was a contest when the ball was thrust deep into attack.

After the Panthers crept to within 13 points five minutes into the last term, McConnell took command to ensure a Tigers victory.

Glenelg bagged eight goals to one in the late splurge.
