Signs are good for Eagles

WOODVILLE-West Torrens coach Ron Fuller has earmarked the next month as an important period for the club in its pursuit of back-to-back titles.

After an indifferent start to the season in which the reigning premiers have secured just two wins in five games, Fuller is confident the Eagles machine is ready to click into gear.

The signs – if yesterday's 29-point victory over Glenelg at Brighton Rd is any indication – certainly back up his thoughts.

"A lot of the boys are starting to roll into some nice form," Fuller said. "Glenelg is a good club and it was a good opportunity to measure ourselves against good quality opposition.

"Each week over the past month we have got better and better and this win was a better

effort again."

Fuller confessed, however, there was "still a fair way to go" and the Eagles were a "fair way off" the type of footy needed to conquer the top sides. What the Eagles are lacking is the conesion which took them to premiership glory last season.

Both sides attacked the contest in a spirited display but it was the Eagles' superior class, experience and the presence of some key targets deep in the forward zone, which proved the difference. Neither team relaxed the pressure and the commitment to tackling created numerous errors and turnovers.

Glenelg was intent on selfdestruction, though, with its overuse of the ball, often getting itself into trouble with an unnecessary desire to handball.

The Eagles appeared set for a pleasant Mother's Day when Adam Grocke goaled after the quarter-time siren to give his side an 18-point buffer.

But the Tigers refused to surrender and kept clawing their way back into contention, cutting the gap to just nine points late in the second term before two Grocke goals again crept the Eagles clear.


By three-quarter time the Eagles, led by Luke Powell on the ball and Mark McKenzie, had blown the lead out to 41 points. Glenelg again rallied with four successive goals but that was the end of the Tigers' threat. The Tigers, touted as a top-five contender, are lamenting at the bottom of the ladder.

If the Eagles are facing an important month of football then the same period is crucial for Glenelg.

Coach Mark Mickan, who chatted with his players for 30 minutes and then the leader-ship group for a further half-hour behind closed doors, said the players' approach to their football needed to change.

"We had an honest discussion on where we sit and what we are going to do about it," he said. "What we are going to do about it is the important thing.

"We have to change a few things about the way we train, the way we give feedback to each other and how honest we are to each other."
