Fierce Panthers stun 'em again

SOUTH Adelaide has done the unthinkable - again.

Just as the Panthers upset Glenelg in Round 1, they repeated the dose at the Bay yesterday, sensationally shapping the Tigers' 12-game winning streak by 13 points.

Everything before the bounce pointed to a comfortable Glenelg win.

The top-of-the-table Tigers were unbackable favourites with the bookies at \$1.02, at full strength and the Panthers – listed at \$11 to winhad lost Power ruckman Brendon Lade and classy Crows wingman David Mackay before the bounce.

But there was one priceless trait the underdog Panthers brought in bucketloads to Brighton Rd – desperation.

Conversely, the tame Tigers had none.

Taking advantage of the cocky Tigers' complacent attitude from the first bounce, South hit the hosts hard with a brand of fierce tackling rarely associated with teams based at Noarlunga.

It led to the visitors laying a staggering 63 tackles to Glenelg's meek 38 – not bad for a side sitting eighth on the table and lacking the same class in personnel.

"That was a fantastic effort, we really emphasised our pressure around the footy," South coach Clay Sampson said.

"Glenelg is the best side at winning the ball inside and I think we matched it with them. It showed our intensity and willingness to work as a group of 21 players."

Nothing epitomised.

South's desire to win more than captain Jason Torney's desperate lunge in the final term, preventing a certain Tiger goal to Todd Grima in the goalsquare.

The Tigers were coming home hard but South, as it had done all afternoon by leading at every change, stood its ground when it mattered most.

It's a fair bet Sampson will never forget his first win at the helm.

"We hadn't won for eight or nine weeks so it was important those guys didn't go back into their shells late in the game," Sampson said.

"There was plenty of desperation and guys putting their bodies on the line, which we hadn't had for several weeks."

None more so than stoic ruckman Craig Parry, who generated his team's proficiency with 34 hitouts, nine more than Glenelg could muster as a team.

"We put that to Paz saying

(Trevor) Cranston's probably the number one ruckman at this stage," Sampson said.

"Paz holds himself in pretty high regard so he stood up for us and gave us that barometer at the start we needed."

Youngsters James Boyd (29 disposals) Peter Rolfe (5.1) and Tarak Redigolo (10 tackles) also shone – a far cry from the toothless Tigers, who had 19 players perform below their best. Only Lucas Block and Byron Murphy could hold their heads high after the siren.

"Our mental approach presented itself as a problem again," Glenelg coach Mark Mickan said, recalling the events of round one.

"We had a poor attitude in the way we approached the game and I've got to take responsibility for that.

"We're all in it together and we'll try and get out of it together."
