GLENELG coach Mark Mickan put the heat on his players to respond to last week's disappointing season opener and they did just that with a convincing victory over Woodville-West Torrens at Brighton Road yesterday.

After dropping last week's clash with South Adelaide, Mickan's demands were met as the Tigers punished the Eagles with the brand of football which swept them into last year's finals.

The Tigers onball brigade, led by back-to-his-best Matthew Bode, smashed the Eagles at the stoppages.

The Eagles were overwhelmed after half-time, having no answer to the Glenelg onslaught and they are now winless after two rounds.

Eagles coach Ron Fuller lamented his side's failure to produce the intensity he wanted. He said his players competed very poorly all over the ground.

In contrast, Mickan praised the manner in which his charges adhered to his pre-match requests and attacked the contest.

"We were very stagnant and slow last week," he said.

"We addressed that, and tried to play quicker and more direct.

"I thought our response was very good."

Tigers ruckman Trevor Cranston was outstanding while his midfield mates Bode, Ben Kane and Adam Fisher created plenty of havoc for the Eagles.

The Tigers continually punched the ball forward and worked tirelessly to deny the Eagles any momentum.

But that was Glenelg's way for the entire battle - the team running hard to get numbers to the contest.

Matthew Duldig was prominent and Ruory Kirkby got busy when Eagles captain Mark McKenzie was moved off him to try to stop a leaking ship elsewhere.

Too often the Eagles turned the ball over with poor disposal or decision making, and the inefficiency going into attack was reminiscent of last week's loss to North Adelaide. Experienced campaigners Leigh Treeby and Luke Powell again gave the Eagles plenty, while Crow youngster Jarrhan Jacky showed plenty of ability.

"We weren't competitive in most places today but certainly the centre square hurt us in the middle quarters," Fuller said.
