# **Battle but eight** straight for Bays

GLENELG overcame a spirited opponent - and a flu outbreak - to move back to the top of the SANFL premiership table with a hard-fought 26-point win against the Panthers yesterday.

One year after having a 12-match winning streak broken by the Noarlunga-based club, the Tigers narrowly averted another massive upset to win their eighth consecutive game.

The one-win Panthers, showing new heart, led late in the third quarter at Gliderol Stadium and trailed by only three points 19 minutes into the final term before being over-run.

In the end, grand finalist Glenelg knew how to win, the Panthers didn't.

With the game on the line, the Tigers dug deep to find another gear with Ruory Kirkby, Josh Willoughby, Todd Grima and Richard O'Grady slamming on goals in a blistering five-minute burst which broke the game wide open. This was a result of a dominance at the stoppages, where ruckman Trevor Cranston was supreme.

"It was a tough game, they made it hard for us and it was only in the last five or so minutes that we got away from them," relieved Glenelg coach Mark Mickan said. "But in the end I was pleased with our fighting qualities to be able to find something under pressure."

Mickan refused to use a flu outbreak among his players as an excuse for his team's erratic display, despite half of the team being bed-ridden during the week and training being disjointed as a result.

"That's no excuse," he said. "Every team gets hit by the flu and once players make themselves available to play the expectation is that they are 100 per cent (fit). I thought to the Panthers' credit they prepared really well for the game and took it right up to us.


"They've been playing well their form belies their spot on the ladder - and they moved the ball really well when they got clean possession, so in the end to come away with the win was pleasing."

If not for the efforts of lionhearted Cranston (35 hit-outs) and strong-marking key forward Ruory Kirkby - who kicked crucial goals under pressure - the Bays would have surrendered

Panthers coach Clay Sampson was left with mixed emotions. For the fourth consecutive week his team has been super competitive but failed to deliver the premiership points. Yesterday's four-goal defeat followed a onepoint loss to Norwood, a
