Tigers scrape a draw in dogfight

GLENELG and Central District each walked away with a premiership point in yesterday's draw at the Bay.

And while there's usually mixed emotions after the siren when scores are tied, you couldn't help sense the Tigers - who trailed all afternoon - drew more satisfaction than the Bulldogs.

Mark Mickan's men, chasing their 10th win in succession, finally looked set to be punished for their woeful goalkicking when last year's premiers led by 22 points seven minutes into the final term.

But after spraying shots on goal most of the day - the Bays kicked 11.15 after a shocking 8.21 last week against Port - Tiger Justin McConnell converted when it counted most.

Less than two minutes after teammate Richard O'Grady put his side within six points, McConnell marked a neat Josh Willoughby pass on the lead, 30m from goal.

Just as the enigmatic forward - who was playing his first league game in more than six weeks - kicked truly, the final siren sounded with scores locked on 81 points, ensuring the hosts stayed perched on top of the premiership ladder.

"He (McConnell) looked threatening all day and it was good for him to be able to nail that goal when we needed it at the end," Glenelg coach Mickan said of the man who finished with 3.2.

While he praised the persistence of his charges, Mickan also noted the Tigers had 31 more disposals, 22 more inside 50m entries and six more scoring shots - giving him plenty to work on.

"We had more of the ball and we needed to do more with it," said Mickan.

"We had wasted opportunities which cost us, so I think

there's a lot of areas for improvement. The players identified that and while they came away from the game with a smile on their face . . . they're understanding that we can do a lot better."

This was certainly the mandate of deflated Central coach Roy Laird, who in his club's 1000th SANFL match watched his men squander a golden chance to edge ahead in the race for the minor premiership.

"It's certainly negative from our point of view," Laird said. "We had a pretty good half in the first half but again we just can't play good footy for long enough, so it's back to the drawing board. It's a very

bearing in mind we were in control of the game (at halftime).

"We had some blokes who cut some corners today and it cost us badly."

Dogs co-captain Paul Thomas worked hard for his 15 possessions, also laying a game-high 10 tackles for his side, while Scott Dutschke (4.0) threatened to tear the game apart with three clever goals before the main change.

"We didn't have too many dominant winners. Dutschke was valuable," Laird said.

"It's a sign when we're going all right that we get an even contribution, but all of us in some area just couldn't sustain it for long enough and that was the key."
