Hard yakka but Tigers too tough

PERSISTENT Glenelg took almost three quarters to wind up to full power – and then blew away patchy Port Adelaide at Alberton yesterday.

The talented Tigers were truly tested before stamping their authority in the final term to grind out a 17-point win in a physical and uncompromising contest between the bitter rivals.

Fumbles and poor decisions by several Magpies late in the game gave Glenelg's leaders a second chance when they might have been slammed into submission by a more efficient opponent.

The lead changed four times in the second half - nine times for the day - and Glenelg didn't hit full flow until four minutes into the final term when tireless Chris Kane (two goals) goaled from 30m to put the Tigers three points up.

After a behind to Port - when Jordan Barham unsuccessfully tried to play on after marking 25m from goal and Brad Murray mopped up with a missed snap - the Tigers' Justin McConnell slipped on the end of a series of handballs to boot his only goal.

That allowed Glenelg to edge nine points clear and closer to their second win for the season.

The ball see-sawed for the next five minutes but, with every second, Glenelg's runners and forwards increased in confidence.

Ruory Kirky – beaten for three quarters by lanky Josh Thurgood – Chris Kane, John Hinge, Josh Willoughby and Mark Ruwoldt finally found space and the Tigers began taking contested marks in attack for the first time.

The fighting Maggies were four points down when strong-marking Barham (5.1) added his fifth goal 13 minutes into the final quarter but by then Glenelg had clicked into a smooth flow and added 2.3 to a solitary point for the remaining 20 minutes.

"We were prepared for a real battle and that's what we got," Glenelg coach Mark Mickan said. "It was just our

Port was tenacious from the first bounce and had the ascendancy in the centre where tireless big man James Meiklejohn, who had more effective hit-outs (25) than Glenelg combined, gave Mark Dolling (26 disposals, four tackles). Steve Summerton (three goals) and Tumby Bay's two-game rookie Jay Shannon (three goals) first look at the ball.

Best-afield Dolling picked up 13 disposals (11 kicks, two handballs) and two powerful tackles in the second term and almost always put the ball to good use throughout the day.

Defenders Corey AhChee, Brad Mercer, Joel Perry and Thurgood were tight but Port - now 0-2 at the foot of the ladder - didn't have enough four-quarter contributors.

"They're just not making the step and we just can't afford to carry one person," Port coach Tim Ginever said.

"We're an extremely competitive team but we can't beat the better teams. The effort is there but the skills were lacking at times."
