Tigers can sniff top spot

GLENELG fought off ardent pressure from Woodville-West Torrens to inch closer to the mantle of minor premier yesterday.

Logging a 26-point win against the Eagles at Gliderol Stadium, Glenelg demonstrated how it became a formidable top-three side in the competition and why it deserves to play deep into September.

With precision and intensity, the Tigers held their opposition at bay in a continuous and fluctuating struggle.

Opening their assault early, the Bays dominated a dazed Eagles in the first quarter and set the tone for the day. An all-in tussle in the Snout's Bar pocket in Glenelg's attacking 50 resulted in the report of Woodville-West Torrens ruckman Brad Dabrowski for alleged rough conduct and a goal from small forward Brett Backwell.

The altercation was a sign that both teams were prepared to put their passion and heart on the line for a win in a finals-like test.

The Eagles charged in the second term, rattling Glenelg slightly and swinging game momentum. Yet the Bays were able to recover with two quick goals through Mark Ruwoldt and Justin McConnell before the close of the term.

Glenelg coach Mark Mickan said he was pleased with his team's commitment and even share of the workload on a tough afternoon.

"After half-time we made a point about maintaining our discipline and we had to get back on top in clearances, which we did. I think we won clearances after half-time and that made a difference," Mickan said.

"The thing we take out of the game is we have to maintain our discipline and our focus for four quarters against good opposition otherwise the scoreboard tends to go against us."

Lucas Block played one of his most solid games for the Bays making concerted second efforts and pushing the ball forward hard and fast. His eight gruelling tackles, five clearances and five inside-50s were crucial to the Tigers' victory.

He was well supported by Crows running forward Richard Douglas and diligent centreman Byron Murphy, who inspired the team with numerous strong and succinct passages of play. Douglas scored two of his three goals in the third term, putting the Bays in the box seat to take out the game at the final break.


The visitors showed class through patches in the second and final terms. When on song, the Eagles shifted the ball from centre square to goal-line with just two or three possessions, usually courtesy of hardworking on-baller Justin Cicolella (22 possessions).

It was a good warm-up for both sides as they increase finals preparations with just one minor round to go. Glenelg is poised to claim the minor premiership if it defeats West Adelaide this weekend.

"We're playing a team next week that are big improvers and we'll be looking to finish off the year in a strong fashion," Mickan said.

Eagles coach Ron Fuller said in the first quarter his charges were a bit "reactive and fumbly" yet they managed to turn that around.

"I think Glenelg's persistence at winning the restarts and 50-50 contests is as good as anyone going around and to be able to match that for three-quarters of the game was pretty good," he said.
