to end hoodoo Bays again fail

GLENELG'S Woodville Oval nightmare has become a fullblown horror show.

Woodville-West Torrens typically spirited and committed - yesterday claimed its 10th win from the past 11 encounters over the Tigers at its home ground with an impressive 30-point win.

The other result was a draw in 2007.

The Eagles absorbed tremendous pressure from the Tigers in the first quarter before blowing the game open in the second when they bagged six goals to two.

Glenelg was guilty of a flood of wasted opportunities in the first term and its 2.9 proved costly.

While Tigers coach Mark Mickan acknowledged the disappointing kicking for goal in the first term did not help his team's cause, he said the game was lost in the second period when his side relinquished control.

"Not only did they outscore us but they simply outplayed us," he said.

"We didn't respond to the situation where we had dominance in the first quarter and, against good quality opposition like the Eagles, we need to be able to raise the bar.

"They dominated us in the second quarter at an unacceptable level."

Glenelg, with the likes of Brett Backwell, Luke Pannozo, Justin McConnell and Mark Ruwoldt picking up plenty of possessions, looked pacy and disciplined in the opening period when they peppered the goals.

The Eagles could not disguise the problems they had clearing the defence against the Glenelg zone when Mickan had a wall of players around the 50m arc.

When the zone was broken, however, the Tigers were exposed by loose Eagles.

The intensity of the entertaining clash lifted in the sec-

ond term with the home side pinning Glenelg in its defensive zone for lengthy periods. The result was a 6.7 quarter for the Eagles as well as momentum.

Matthew Broadbent, Luke Jarrad and Sam Fairclough got busy while Nick Salter loomed dangerously in attack.

The Tigers failed to show Eagle midfielder Leigh Treeby respect and Jarrhan Jacky, whose spring from a standing position was amazing, was lively in the forward zone.

Glenelg lost Backwell and Todd Grima to shoulder injuries for most of the second half although they were able to close the gap to 17 points at three-quarter time.

The Eagles should have been further ahead, though, only to waste chances with poor delivery and decision-making going into attack.

But they were always able to keep the Tigers, who became uncertain at times in the final quarter, at arm's length.

"The record says we can't win here," Mickan said, "The last place we could not win was Alberton and we won there last year and recently.

"I don't like to think this is a place we can't win."


