Bays step right direction

GLENELG washed its hands of its embarrassing Anzac Day loss with a solid 26-point win over the Panthers at Noarlunga yesterday.

Despite a third-quarter brain fade. Glenelg managed to storm home in the final term courtesy of some classy handiwork by seasoned campaigner Adam Fisher and two inspired goals from Todd Grima.

The Tigers still seemed underdone by last year's standards but were pleased to come away with the two premiership points in a tough game.

Port Adelaide's Josh Carr, responded strongly to his shock AFL omission with a well-rounded performance for the Bays. Under the ever-watchful eye of Power coach Mark Williams, Carr collected 18 possessions in the first half alone and 35 for the game. It will most likely be one of very few games he plays for Glenelg this year.

His game-style of hard at the body and the ball matched that of Fisher as they worked the midfield together.

Tigers coach Mark Mickan said the team achieved what he wanted it to nothing more, nothing less.

"It was good in terms of an effort response - our effort was far better and we had far more complete team efforts - but there are still plenty of errors for us to iron out." Mickan said. "But what we came here to do was to show a lot more intensity and competitiveness and we did that."

Mickan confessed the third quarter in which South scored five goals to Glenelg's one - was a result of the

Bays' sloppy disposals and the Panthers' increased pressure. However, he credited the team for rectifying that in the final term.

"I think we did do that a lot better and scored from our possessions rather than turn them over like we did in the third. What we're looking for is to be better over four quarters. We still gave the ball back too easily sometimes under pressure. Those possessions we need to hit the target that's what we need to improve on."

The Panthers started strongly with Crows recruit Shaun McKernan proving a useful tall in the forward line. The side also welcomed back Adam Cockshell from a finger injury for his first game for South and although he played well he was at times the victim of the Panthers' misguided plan to play wide.

When confident, South was strong in the corridor and young gun Nathan Lyons created plenty of opportunities in the goalsquare. But what coach Clay Sampson needs now is stability and growth from his young side. Of the starting 21, 12 players have logged less than 10 league games. "Our ability to stay in the game for three quarters was a lot better than it has been and we'll take a positive out of that," Sampson said. "Our intensity and pressure was a lot better than it has been in the first few weeks. We had a real belief we could win the game but unfortunately we didn't finish off as well as we would have liked."
