Racial row mars Tigers victory

GLENELG forward Todd Grima is to front the SANFL tribunal on Tuesday night on an alleged racial vilification charge.

Grima was reported for misconduct by umpire Tony Dey in the first quarter of Glenelg's five-point victory at the Bay yesterday for allegedly racially vilifying North Adelaide's Wade Thompson.

Grima spoke to Thompson as the pair walked from the ground after the game. The key Tigers forward, along with coach Mark Mickan and football manager Ken Applegarth, then met Thompson, Roosters coach Daniel Healy and football manager James Moore.

Thompson and the Roosters were satisfied with the outcome after Grima told them it was a misunderstanding of words.

Importantly, there was no remonstration from Thompson or his team-mates near the incident.

The Tigers have shrugged off the woes of the Anzac Day drubbing from Central District to climb to second on the premiership ladder with victories over the Panthers and the Roosters.

"The effort was terrific," Mickan said.

"The players are trying to play the style of game we are trying to implement.

"We still have a while to go with our execution.'

The tone of the contest was established early with Glenelg dominating entries inside the attacking 50 only to let itself down with wasted opportunities in front of goal.

Ruckman Trevor Cranston showed he had rediscovered his true form to control the stoppages and set the home side alight.

The Roosters, despite leading at quarter-time and then trailing at half-time by just a goal, struggled for clean ball from the stoppages against the Tigers midfield.

Roosters skipper Damon White was brilliant at centrehalf back to help his side stay in the battle while Toby

Stribling, having a productive season, mopped up plenty of ball deep in defence.

However, Cranston's impact on the contest was most noticeable in the early minutes of the final quarter.

But skill errors from his team-mates in defence, amid the tension of the last term, almost cost the side the two premiership points.

Unfortunately for Rooster fans, their side failed to take advantage.

"If you look at the numbers, they smashed us inside 50 and they probably had more of the ball," Healy said.

"You look at that and they deserved to win."
