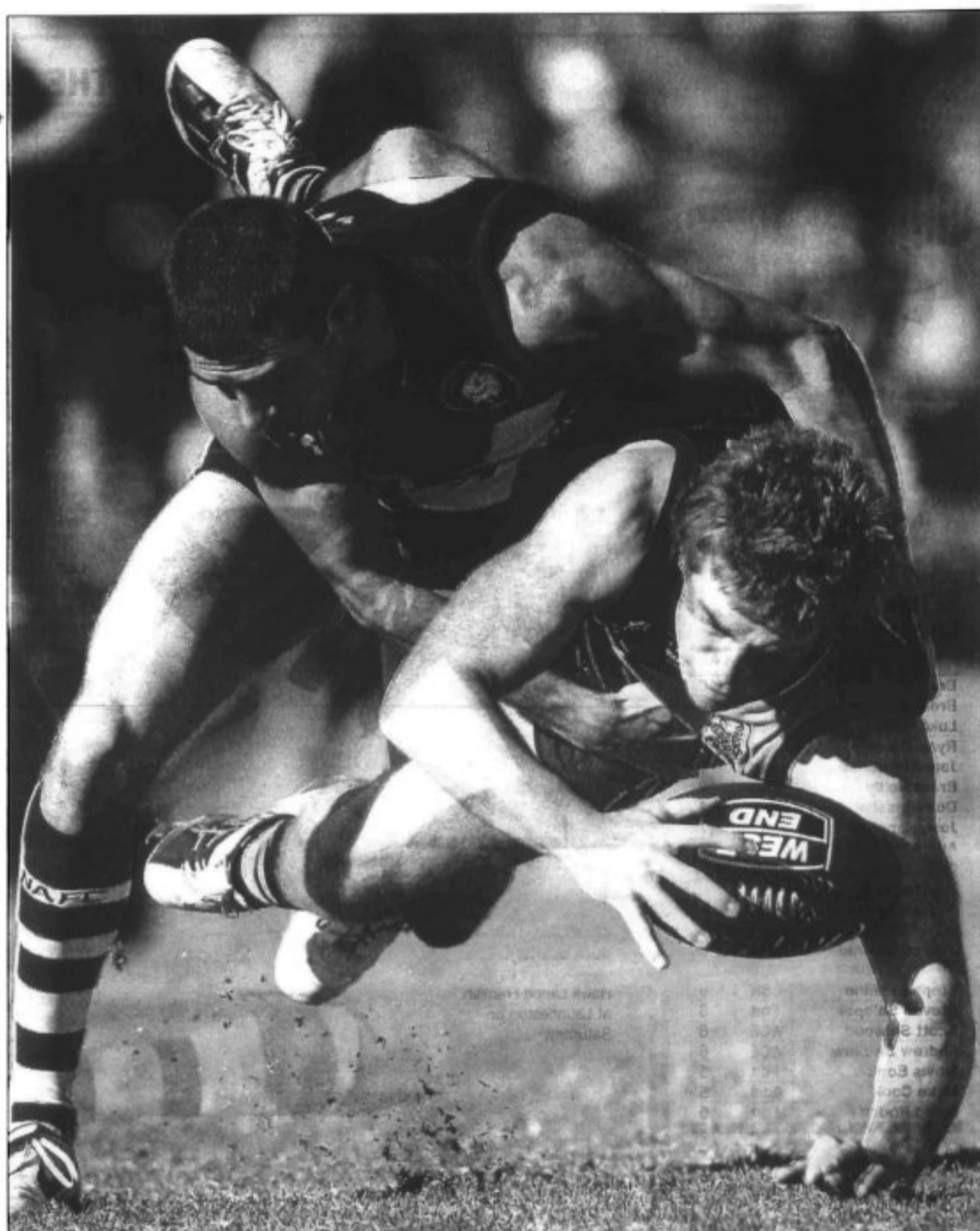

GLENELG put aside three quarters of patchy football to blast North Adelaide off the park with a nine goal-to-one final term at Gliderol Stadium yesterday.

Inspired by best-on-ground midfielder Byron Murphy, who left the field just before half-time bleeding from the face following an incident with North's Clint Alleway, the Tigers made it nine straight wins over the Roosters with a 47-point triumph.

There was some genuine feeling in the game with almost every player involved in a heated scuffle at the half-time siren.

"The players had some feeling, they've got some real feeling for each other, they don't like seeing their other mates get hurt, so it's just how you respond to that is what's important," Glenelg coach Mark Mickan said.

"We talked about that at half-time. We said the best way to respond to that is on the scoreboard and with our effort and the way we play, just being hard at the footy. And maybe it took until the last quarter for that to really happen but it was a good response.

"We really put our heads over the ball and started to get a bit of control."

Mickan described Murphy as "a very tough customer" and he finished with 25 possessions, while skipper Ben

North was right in the game and had its chances but was made to pay for wayward shots on goal and loose tackling. Djaran Whyman and Leigh Ryswyk were lively, Matt Wright worked hard on the ball, Damon White provided a target, Ben Williams did some good things and Cain Ackland made a good return to league ranks. But North was found wanting in the final term.

Little separated the teams in the first half and despite James Sellar kicking his second goal, Wade Thompson and Toby Stribling kept the Roosters in touch at the main break. Allen and Luke Panozzo lifted in the third term and Kirkby and Todd Grima started to have an impact but the Tigers still couldn't shake North, which made most of the play.

The Roosters snatched the lead with goals to Ryswyk and Williams but it was

short-lived as Bode split a pack wide open and kicked a 60m goal on the run to put the Bays two points up at the final change.

From there it was all one-way traffic with Chris Kane goaling from a 25m penalty, then Angus Lally, who had been quiet all day, bobbed up with a snap shot on goal and it was all over.

Mickan said his team lifted after it started winning the ball in the clinches.

"They (North) got control of the stoppages in the first half ... and it wasn't until really in the last quarter that we got control of the stoppage area of the game, then our ball movement and handball became more efficient.

"What we really wanted to do today was play four good quarters. I reckon we played a good first and a good last - that's still a work in progress for us to try to put four good quarters together."
