

Tigers move a step closer to lighting up

GLENELG'S quest to play under lights at Gliderol Stadium next year has moved a significant step closer with the Labor Government pledging \$190,000 for the project.

While the Tigers are still awaiting approval from the Holdfast Bay Council, the financial backing - contingent on Labor retaining office after Saturday's federal election - would cover more than half the projected cost.

"Robin Johnson Engineering have been absolutely fantastic for us and they've been quoting us a cost of around the \$320,000 to \$330,000 mark," Glenelg president Gary Metcalf said.

"We know we have general support from the council and what we require now is for that support to be put into action over the next period so we can move forward."

The Tigers - also eager to host Redbacks cricket matches under lights at the Bay - are confident night fixtures would boost attendances and catering revenue.

"It would give us an opportunity to extend what we can do at the club and invite other

BAYS BLOW WILLOUGHBY HIT FOR SIX

Glenelg has suffered a double blow with hard-running pair Josh Willoughby and Andrew Bradley expected to miss up to six weeks with leg injuries. Bradley fractured his fibula last weekend and is in a moon boot, while Willoughby will have scans on the knee he injured in Saturday's win over the Eagles.

"The first prognosis is it's a sporting fraternities here," Metcalf said. "We could have kids' sport here and have cricket here, which makes sure this club becomes viable for 52 weeks of the year and not just 15 weeks while we're playing footy."

"It was fantastic that West Adelaide had 6000 at their first game (under lights at Richmond) and I think we could look forward to averaging 10,000 because we're averaging 4800 now."

TWO Glenelg greats were inducted into the Tigers' Hall of Fame at the Bay on Saturday night. Neville "Twiggy" Caldwell and David Holst took to 39 the number of former stars in Glenelg's Hall

of Fame, which recognises and enshrines players who have made a significant contribution to the Glenelg Football Club since its entry into the SANFL in 1921. Caldwell, a skilful, long-kicking utility, was ahead of his time, combining 192cm height with pace to burn. He played 265 games and kicked 258 goals between 1970-1981 and was a member of the 1973 premiers team. Holst was a strongly built midfielder who threw himself into the fray, burst through packs and loved nothing more than mixing it with opposition iron men. He played 190 games and kicked 109 goals between 1975-1985.
