IT TOOK just 30 minutes of champagne football for Glenelg to set up a solid 47-point win over a hapless South Adelaide and to expose the glaring difference in attitude and talent that exists between the southern rivals, at Noarlunga yesterday.

With irresistible run and teamwork, the consummate Tigers blasted nine unanswered goals in the second term and belted South in every aspect of football.

Glenelg went from a 15-point deficit after the first term, to lead by 40 points 30 minutes later. More importantly, their cohesion, superior methods and talent, bashed the Panthers into total submission.

South scratched out a solitary point for the term and went goalless from the 23rd minute of the first quarter to four minutes into the third, when Shaun McKernan unleashed his incredible leap to pull down a specky and goal.

It was embarrassing for the South faithful during the second term to see the Tigers parade their skills with total disregard to South's meek efforts, which could not contain or challenge the SANFL heavyweight.

Glenelg - which wasted shots at goal in the opening term with 2.5 - had 42 more disposals than the Panthers by half-time and a staggering 97 more touches by the last break.

The game was decided when diminutive former Crows rover Matthew Bode - who had eight hard-won touches for the term - AFL experienced Kane Tenace (nine),

Angus Lally (six), Ben Murphy (six) and Ben Kane (five) took advantage of the ruck dominance of athletic Trevor Cranston (28 hit outs, four tackles), to tear apart South's vaunted midfield.

They drove the ball deep and long to towering Todd Grima (5.2) and "Rocking" Ruory Kirkby (5.1), who continually outmarked their overwhelmed opponents. Skipper Ben Mules (nine) continually rebounded from half-back, underrated Luke Pannozzo, Chris Kane and Ty Allen did as they pleased, and James Sellar was a handy back-up on the few occasions Cranston took a spell.

Glenelg's dominance was clear until the final term when their methods fell away and South kicked 4.3 to 1.4 to hide some embarrassment, which angered Tigers' coach Mark Mickan.

"Our tackle count fell away, the effectiveness of the ball use fell away and the forward pressure dropped off as well," he said. "Why that happens ... I can't put a finger on it right now but during the week we've got to look at it. I wouldn't say it was a great win. We got the job done but not with the intensity we require."

Mickan has fewer worries then South's Ron Fuller, who refused to claim any positives from the final term.

"We won't be taking that into next week (against Central District)," he said. "It (game) was a great lesson for us about wanting front position, meeting the ball hard, putting pressure on the opposition - all the things we want to do well."
