Ton-up Bryce makes Bays pay the price

IT had been eight long years since Norwood triumphed at Brighton Road.

That is nine trips down Anzac Highway without a win. Redlegs coach Nathan Bassett mentioned the losing streak was "part of the motivation" in the lead-up to yesterday's 14-point triumph over Glenelg at the home of the Tigers.

"But what we want is to play the best footy we can and keep playing our style against a side which plays a little differently to other SANFL sides," Bassett said.

At quarter-time he made haste to his players and immediately huddled them together. He was far from satisfied after the Tigers had claimed the high ground and led by 13 points.

"I did not think we were particularly clean, our pressure was not particularly good around the ball and our defensive spread was poor," Bassett said. "The main message was to work harder back and spread from the contest. I thought we were OK with the footy, we just didn't have it."

The Tigers deserved the lead. They had 30 more possessions, their ball use was far more effective and they had more potency in the forward zone. When Darcy Armfield nailed a goal seven minutes into the second quarter, the Tigers had an 18-point buffer and were giving supporters reason to hope in what has been an indifferent season.


