AN angry and frustrated West Adelaide coach Andrew Collins wants to know why the Bloods were tagged the undisciplined team in yesterday's 45-point loss to Glenelg at Brighton Rd.

Refusing to hide his feelings, Collins said a period leading up to half-time when the Bloods were punished with a quick succession of umpiring calls had influenced the game. The Bloods had come from 34 points down at quarter-time to grab the lead and have the ascendancy against a Tigers outfit which had been winless for six weeks.

"Why were we viewed as the undisciplined team when we had the flow?" Collins said. "I'd say it takes two to tango and we had the flow so there was no need for our team to lose it.

"I'm looking forward to watching the replay. There was definitely a 25m penalty against (Bloods' on-baller) Ben Macreadie but who retaliated then? We have been labelled an undisciplined team and I'm disappointed there was not an equal surmise of the situation."

The Bloods had control when the clash became heated and umpiring decisions resulted in three quick goals to the Tigers.

To further boil Collins' blood. the start of the third quarter was a repeat of the first with the Bloods penalised before the ball had even been bounced.

The text message from the Glenelg fan late in the final quarter said the Bays were back. Yep, they are back in the top five on the ladder. And Kris Massie also got his first win as league coach at his second attempt after

replacing Mark Mickan.

But to say the Tigers are back is a little premature. This was a below-strength Bloods outfit which has not tasted victory at the the home of the Tigers for years. And again the Bloods coughed up too many clumsy turnovers at crucial times.

Massie said he was relieved with the result and overall he was extremely pleased.

"I'm relieved, more so for the playing group considering what the club has been through," Massie said. "It is a positive result but what I focused on is how the guys went about it.
