

Bloods on a high after Bays crash

WEST Adelaide's highly encouraging early season form continued last night with a 37-point victory over Glenelg at City Mazda Stadium.

The ladder-leading Bloods went on the rampage in the final quarter to earn their fifth victory of the season from six games and inspire more optimism for the club.

Both sides were guilty of an avalanche of mistakes and skill errors and the loss puts further pressure on coach Mark Mickan to find the answers.

The fact it took 23 minutes for a goal to be registered - Glenelg's Cameron Hitchcock kicked truly from a set shot outside the 50m arc - was a reflection of the lack-lustre first quarter when scoring opportunities were rare.

Glenelg had a desire to zig-zag up the field with the ball while the Bloods, struggling against the Tigers zone, were clumsy and lacked method with their movement. It made for some unattractive and frustrating action as both sides lacked authority.

When Power-listed Chad Cornes marked strongly and goalled on the quarter-time siren the visitors led by 15 points and had the momentum.

Too many Tigers found space in the corridor but the desire to constantly switch play enabled the Bloods to retreat players into defence. However, Ruory Kirkby gave the Tigers a 20-point buffer seven minutes into the second quarter and the high ground. The Bloods lacked method with their movement and players crashed into each other attempting to mark more than once. Fortunato Caruso snapped the Bloods' opening goal 11 minutes into the second quarter and a minute later they had their second when Ben Macreadie kicked truly.

The Tigers again blasted clear, only to cough up two goals late in the first half to the home side with shocking errors. If the fans were hoping for a lift in standard in the second half the early minutes offered little encouragement with a swag of turnovers. Poor decision making was also a constant.

What made the game interesting was the close scores because this was not a game for the highlights reel.

Shane Birss cut the gap to only three points early in the third quarter before Cornes replied with his second goal.

The Bloods at least matched the Tigers for desire and Sam Ezard, the younger brother of Magarey Medallist James making his league debut for the club, fueled his side's spirits with his first goal.

Matthew Lobbe then gave the Bloods the lead when he goaled and Aaron Fielke stretched the margin to eight points with a handy major.

Glenelg key forward Todd Grima, who was reported in the third quarter, kicked a goal a minute into the final term before the home side resplied with the next three goals.
