NORTH Adelaide needs the big-game challenge.

The Roosters conquered Norwood with an impressive brand of footy four weeks back and West Adelaide last week.

Two weeks ago they lost to Port Adelaide when coach Josh Francou lamented the fact his players failed to approach the contest with the right attitude. Yesterday, the Roosters claimed a 58-point victory over Glenelg at Brighton Road.

But it is a measure of the path travelled under Francou that the Roosters can secure a hefty win at a ground where they had dropped seven of their previous eight encounters and be far from satisfied.

The Roosters had 13 more scoring shots, 79 more possessions and 16 more visits inside their 50m - yet led by 28 points eight minutes into the final quarter. That desperate passion shown against the top sides was missing for lengthy periods. It is also an indication of how the Tigers are travelling. Without their AFL content they are at

serious risk of falling to the bottom of the ladder.

Even when the Tigers adopted one-on-one tactics and made a run at the Roosters in the third quarter to close the gap to 17 points, it was more a case of the seemingly complacent Roosters' lack of conviction than what the home side was doing.

Francou used the word lazy to describe his team in the third term. He also noted the sloppy disposal and a lack of polish in front of goal.

"I said in the box in the third quarter the match did not have a good feel," Francou said. "But it is the development of the club and the progression we have made that we came here and got the job done, now we focus on Central (District on Sunday). It probably shows the steps we have taken over the past couple of years."

The Roosters were always threatening when they had possession but too often they wasted scoring chances because of a skill error.

The Tigers also had skill issues and clumsy football dropped marks or missed handballs - was a problem.
