

Tigers stand up to West pressure

GLENELG snapped a seven-game losing streak with a spirited eight-point triumph over West Adelaide at Glenelg Oval last night.

The Tigers were never headed in the tough battle and claimed just their third win for the season to give themselves a chance to avoid the wooden spoon. The loss could be costly for the seventh-placed Bloods, two games outside the top five, in their pursuit of a finals berth.

"This is enormous for the club and great for a young group that has worked really hard," Tigers coach Nick Stevens said. "We know we have been building and the encouraging thing was we got challenged and our boys really stood up, got challenged again and stood up again." The scoreboard attendant was kept

while Max Proud continued his productive form in defence.

As the match lengthened, so too did the Tigers' pressure and they made life tough for the visitors with their tackling and harassment. The opening quarter ended in controversy when an attempt at goal by Tiger Andrew Hooper was called a behind.

The Bloods charged the ball into attack before the game was halted and the goal umpire altered Hooper's behind to a goal to give the Tigers a quarter-time 21-point advantage.

Not that the action ended with the siren, as the two teams became involved in a melee in the centre square.

The Tigers were winning the battles in tight and moving the ball with confidence and the buffer grew to 28 points early in the second quarter.
