

NORWOOD was forced to defuse a spirited Glenelg challenge to snap a three-game losing streak with a 17-point victory at the Bay last night.

The Redlegs were never headed in the entertaining contest but they had to fight for their first premiership points since the opening-round triumph over Port Adelaide.

Superior composure at critical moments and enthusiasm for the scrap enabled the Redlegs to bounce back.

There was plenty of intent in the Redlegs' endeavour early in the battle and they went on the attack with the game style which has proved so effective in recent years.

The visitors were camped in their forward zone for lengthy periods, feeding off ruckman Sam Baulderstone's work to constantly be on the charge.

The defensive structures of the Redlegs smothered the Tigers and the home side struggled to escape from defence. The Legs' pressure created turnovers and they were only too willing to accept the gifts to keep the Bays on the back foot.

It took the Tigers 17 minutes to register their first goal -Ruory Kirkby taking a trademark strong mark before nailing the set shot. A glaring statistic to reflect the Redlegs' dominance was their 22 visits inside their attacking 50m compared to just 10 six minutes into the second quarter. Norwood was cleaner in the testing conditions and worked tirelessly to make an option.

Trailing by 31 points 10 minutes into the second term, the Tigers started to retrieve more possessions and get some momentum as they challenged the Redlegs with growing passion for the contest. Midfielder Sam Lonergan, Lewis Hender and Lachlan Button got busy

cit to just seven points late in the second quarter when captain Andrew Bradley received a free kick in defence. But the kick was reversed because of an undisciplined act and Redleg Peter Persinos goaled to punish the Tigers.

The early minutes of the third quarter mirrored the first with the Redlegs testing the resolve of the Bays with their pressure and intensity.

Norwood youngster Peter Bampton thrived in the wet, slippery conditions and he had a significant influence in the visitors building a 27-point buffer. But again the Tigers responded, getting in the face of their opponents as they lifted their workrate.




