Glenelg adds to Roosters woes

NORTH Adelaide's horror season continued at Prospect Oval yesterday, losing to a much slicker Glenelg in slushy conditions by 62 points and adding another four players to its extensive injury list.

The Roosters would have given themselves a big chance to win their second game of the year, and first since round two, after pushing Central District last week.

But the Tigers were far too strong, particularly after half-time when they booted 13 goals to six and inflicted North's seventh defeat by at least 60 points this season.

The visitors played a positive brand of football while dominating all the key statistics - disposals (381-259), marks (79-43), clearances (67-34) and inside 50s (49-35).

Making matters worse for North, which already has about 10 first-choice players sidelined, Max Thring (hamstring), Jesse O'Brien (groin), Todd Miles (groin), George Thring (ankle) were injured during the game.

Roosters caretaker coach Michael Handby said his initiation - six losses at an average of 69.33 points - had been tough but team spirit remained high.

"I'm obviously disappointed again," Handby said. "We were limited by rotations again ... and we've fallen away."

Handby blamed bad luck and being "behind in a lot of areas" at the start of pre-season for the highest injury count he had seen in his time in football.

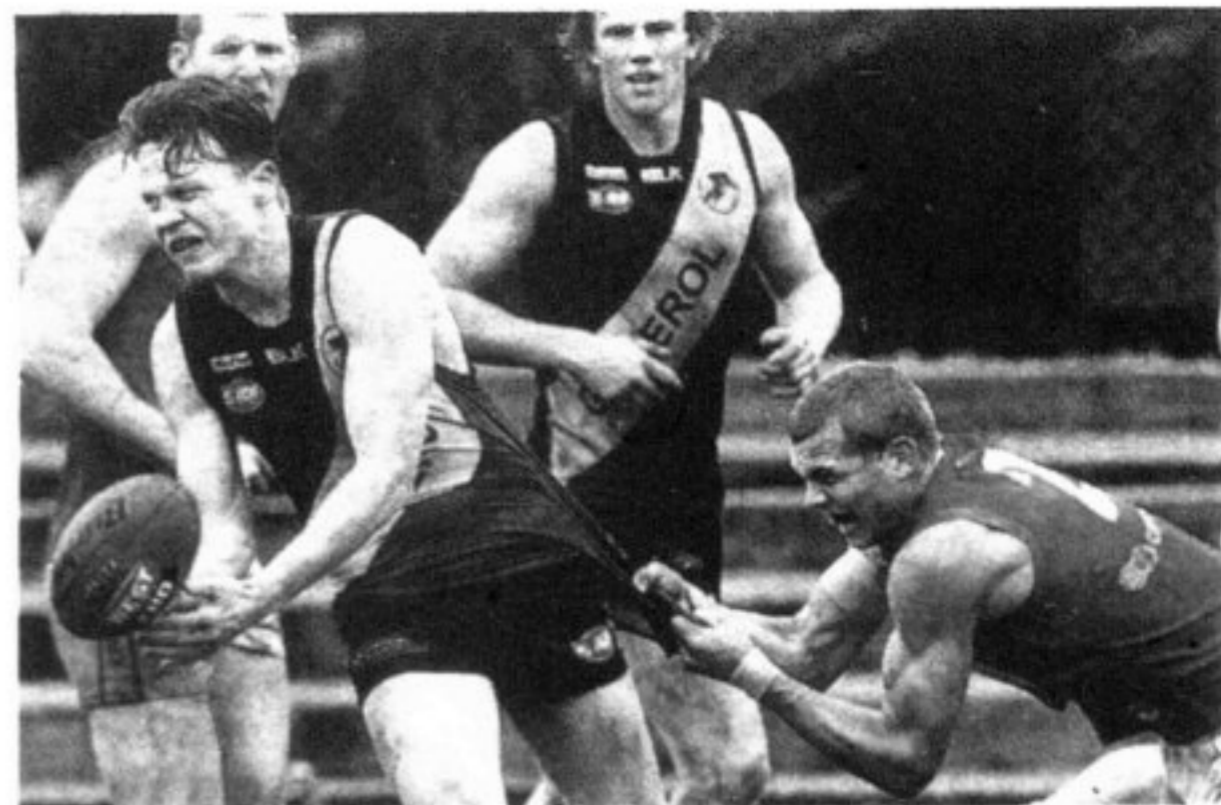

Tigers coach Matthew Lokan said his side was building towards becoming a consistent unit.

"To be able to play four quarters is something we've struggled a little bit to do so to get that consistency and finish off the game well ... was very pleasing," he said.
